This email serves as notification of the start of soil boring work proposed in our July 31, 2017 *Work Plan Addendum*. The work will be conducted on September 19, 2017; boring will only be completed in the interior of the former dry cleaner unit due to drilling equipment availability with the purpose of defining the extent of contamination surrounding the source area. As proposed in the work plan, a dual tube sampling system will be employed and drilling in the vicinity of the source area will be limited to approximately 20 feet bgs to avoid drag down of contamination in this area.

Following soil boring, sub-slab vent piping will be placed and replacement of the slab in the former dry cleaner unit is tentatively scheduled for late next week. Any portion of the slab left open in the former dry cleaner unit to allow for anticipated future remediation efforts will be securely covered with plastic sheeting.
