We will also provide you with a response from this agency. Grab groundwater sampling was conducted during previous phases of investigation that helped identify the proposed area of excavation as the likely source area for tetrachloroethene (PCE). Further groundwater investigation that includes monitoring well installation and sampling is currently underway. A remedial action plan to conduct long-term groundwater remediation using enhanced reductive dechlorination is also under consideration for the site. The groundwater remediation plan prepared by Roux Associates is available on the State Water Resources Control Board GeoTracker website.

No remediation plans have been approved for this site to date. We are in a public comment period during which all comments will be considered prior to approval. In addition, we have also asked the responsible party for further evaluation of potential maximum emissions during aeration. With regard to consideration of receptors, all potential receptors will be considered. Thank you for your input and identification of potential receptors.
