Site Remediation Summary

This fact sheet has been prepared to inform community members and other interested stakeholders regarding the status of a proposed soil cleanup at the Cross Alameda Trail Site located along the south side of Ralf Appezzato Parkway between Webster St. and Main St, Alameda, California. The City of Alameda, the lead responsible party for the contaminated property case is proposing to cap or restrict access to contaminated soil at the site.

Site Background

The site is located along the south side of Ralf Appezatto Memorial Parkway but is now currently a vacant or paved tract of land. Plans to redevelop the property to a bicycle and pedestrian trail have been approved by the City of Alameda and will be constructed concurrently with remediation at the site. The shallow soil at the site contains elevated levels of lead, arsenic, and polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs).

Remediation Alternative: Capping with Soil and Pavement, Access Restriction to Uncapped Areas. Three lead and arsenic hotspot areas have been identified. Additionally, the entire site has an elevated human health risk due to Marsh Crust and PAHs in shallow soil. The proposal is to cover the trail area and north to the parkway with either a 2 foot thick engineered soil cap or pavement. The area south of the trail will be fenced, vegetated, and have restricted access. Contaminated soil will not be removed from the site.

Next Step

The City of Alameda is working with Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) to implement a soil cleanup at the

site. The proposed alternative is described in the report *Remedial Action Plan dated* April 14, 2017 prepared by Tetra Tech on behalf of the City of Alameda. The public is invited to review and comment on the proposed cleanup action.
