Dear Mr. Mulligan,

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) is in receipt of a work plan entitled *Soil Excavation Work Plan* (Work Plan), dated April 6, 2015 and prepared by Arcadis U.S., Inc. (Arcadis) for the subject site. On March 27, 2015, ACEH requested funds as a deposit for regulatory oversight. ACDEH considers the receipt of the funds as an acknowledgement that Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) has entered into a Voluntary Cleanup Agreement with ACDEH. ACDEH has not received the funds.

Without funds, ACEH cannot proceed with a review of the Work Plan or a review of the case file. Therefore, ACDEH requests the submittal of a check made payable to Alameda County Environmental Health in the amount of \$6,000.00 as a deposit for regulatory oversight. Please send your check to the attention of our Finance Department. This deposit may or may not be sufficient to provide all necessary regulatory oversight. Funds received by ACDEH for cases such as yours, are held in a deposit/refund account. The deposit/refund account is charged on an hourly basis as case work is performed. If these funds are insufficient, an additional deposit will be requested. Otherwise, any unused monies will be refunded to you or your designee.

The deposit is authorized in Section 6.92.040L of the Alameda County Ordinance Code. Work on this project is being debited at the Ordinance specified rate, currently \$204.00 per hour. Please write "SCP" (the type of project), account number "AR0345133", and the site address on your check.
