Below is the contact information and very brief description of the incident

On March 26, 2015 ACDEH was notified by CalOES spill notification center that a diesel locomotive released approximately 4,000 gallons of diesel fuel on to the ground at 1408 Middle Harbor Road, Oakland. The diesel has impacted soil in an area of the rail yard approximately 200 feet by 30 feet on track 58. Cleanup is being performed by NRC and work plan/sampling is being performed by Arcadis
