Sorry to append to this message; however, in reviewing Geotracker I noticed that no uploads of boring logs, analytical EDFs, GEO\_MAPS, or any other items required by the State Water board (SWB) have been provided by The Source Group or Cardino. This WILL delay closure, and becomes a substantial headache to accept the entire lot all at one time. Additionally and more importantly, no documentation or data has made available to the general public through Geotracker who might have an interest in the redevelopment. This request has been made at least several times and at least several submittal dates have not been met. This is an important issue due to this. Please attend to the uploads ASAP.

Thanks for the notice. I have taken the opportunity to review the "SMP Amendment Summary" received from Chris Brawer of Anchor Valley Partners on September 20 2017, which summarizes a proposed change in the manor of excavation of Area 1 (from slot trenches to large diameter auger), and proposed changes to confirmation sampling in both Areas (changing from discrete confirmation samples to composite confirmation samples). The reason for ACDEH's request for discrete confirmation samples was detailed in the attached directive letter (Comment 1b). This request has not changed, including the sidewall (or lateral extents)

confirmation samples. Composite samples are appropriate for disposal purposes, but not confirmation sampling to verify that any residual contamination is as expected. Please observe the request.
