Dear Mr. Uranga:

I am contacting you regarding the above referenced site, which is currently owned by the City of Livermore. As you know, Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) opened a case for this site in August 2015 based on evidence of soil and groundwater contamination originating from a leaking underground storage tank (UST) system that existed at the site from the 1960s until the mid-1970s. ACDEH sent a directive on August 20, 2015, requesting a work plan to further investigate the site to determine the nature and extent of residual contamination and how this may affect potential future redevelopment.

I took over as ACDEH's case manager after Jerry Wickham's retirement in January of this year. Since July, I have been in contact with Polo Munoz from MidPen Housing, the developer for the site, and Ian Sutherland from ACC Environmental Consultants. A meeting has been scheduled for tomorrow at 9 am between ACDEH, Mr. Munoz, and Mr. Sutherland to discuss the next steps to move the case forward.

Mr. Munoz informed me that he is in regular contact with you regarding this site's progress. However, I wanted to invite you to attend or teleconference this meeting if you are able. It will be held at our office at 1131 Harbor Bay Parkway in Alameda on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. If you are able to teleconference, please let me know the best number to call to reach you.
