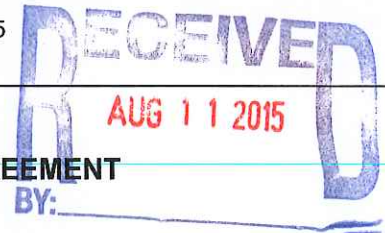

During a routine facility upgrade, crude oil stained soil was observed beneath an out of service storage tank. After some investigative excavation, it was determined that the oil impacted soil clean-up was beyond the capabilities of company personnel and would require third-party clean-up services.
