Hi Joe.

The temporary use of the site as a hand car wash sounds like a great idea. However, I have a few reservations I'd like addressed prior to providing my final input.

I'm am unfamiliar with the term "Hand Car Wash". My concern is the introduction of a significant quantity of water to the subsurface, potentially affecting the established groundwater flow, particularly after the drought we have been experiencing. There are references in the former case file, RO0000251, that pea gravel was used as tank backfill. Pea gravel is pervious and may create a bathtub should the former tank pit fill with water. It has been my experience the "bathtub effect" releases water radially outward, not just in the prevailing direction of groundwater flow. Additionally, if the ground cover is not impervious, dripping of vehicle fluids may entail the removal of near surface soil to eliminate the vertical migration of the fluids into the subsurface.

I see below that the subject of the water run off (and potential percolation) may be addressed by others, hence may not be a concern.

Please provide Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) a more detailed description of the proposed "Hand Car Wash" operation for our review prior to making a determination regarding the car wash. Please include a description of the condition of the surface of the site and the location of the proposed car wash.
