I received the lab report for the soil gas sample in front of the building (boring SB-3) and results as follows:

Methane – 9 uL/L or 0.0009 % - LEL is 5%

Napthalene – ND (RL = 11 ug/m³ or 0.002 uL/L) – ESL for soil gas is 41 ug/m³ (Feb 2016)

We are set to drill the last two borings on this Friday August 5. No additional soil gas sampling is planned.
