I understand the desire to avoid the added cost to perform extra offsite assessment that would otherwise be evaluated by the proposed sampling within the Workplan for Site Assessment and Remediation Pilot Study dated October 25, 2016.

However prior to ACDEH authorization to conduct onsite investigation activities proposed in the October 25, 2016 Work Plan the following items must be completed:

1) The draft Workplan to Address Ponding Water dated XXXXX submitted to ACDEH via email on 2/3/2017 must be finalized and uploaded to Geotracker and the ftp databases along with a copy of the City of Oakland's permit B1600468 for storm water and site drainage (see email correspondence from Rich Fielding to Danny dated January 30, 2017.) ACDEH is reviewing the Workplan and will provide comments on the plan tomorrow. Comments must be addressed in the

final workplan uploaded to Geotracker and the ftp site.

- 2) The stormwater dewatering activities must be implemented in accordance with the ACDEH approved Work Plan and city permit.
- 3) Additional site stabilization measures outlined in Tracy Craig's email correspondence to Danny dated January 30, 2017 and summarized below must be implemented:
- Clean up the site exterior and interior
- Board up interior areas of the site so people cannot access the upstairs regions
- Hire a security firm to watch the site evenings/weekends
- Install motion-sensor lighting
- Send a mass email out to December 7th meeting attendees letting them know what your plans for continued communications and follow up on these

Although the items listed in Item 3 above are related to the site demolition and redevelopment activities and not the environmental investigation, ACDEH will not grant authorization to conduct onsite investigation activities until these community concerns have been addressed.

Please not that ACDEH will require offsite investigation activities to proceed independently of the onsite investigation activities if the items listed above are not completed in an expeditious manner. If you would like to avoid the cost of conducting onsite and offsite assessment independently you must submit a schedule for implementation of the items listed above by this Thursday 2/9/2017. The schedule must show completion of the above listed activities by February 24, 2017. ACDEH will provide written authorization to proceed with onsite investigation activities upon receipt of documentation that the items have been complete.

If the County is closer to allowing onsite assessment, Danny would like to avoid the added cost to perform extra offsite assessment that would otherwise be evaluated by the proposed sampling within the October 25, 2016 workplan.
