Hi Jeremy,

Can you please provide Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) with a complete summary of the work and their status (also include an updated schedule for this work) associated with the environmental work for the site. This will be for ALL work done since the March 31, 2017 Meeting between ACDEH, City of Oakland and 1919 Crew including the following:

- Offsite and Perimeter Site Assessment – Includes authorized work as per ACDEH directive dated March 3, 2017 (collection of 10 soil gas samples and 1 crawl space/indoor air sample along the perimeter of the site and offsite to assess vapor intrusion risks).
- Addendum for Site Assessment – Includes authorized work as per ACDEH directive dated April 21, 2017 (collection of additional soil gas at locations adjacent to six residences along Myrtle Street, and the collection of soil and groundwater from six location around the perimeter of the site). In addition, mention all community outreach efforts, permitting activities, when you plan on drilling/sampling etc. (i.e. request for building foundation information, encroachment permitting, etc.)
- Crawlspace and ambient air sampling at the church property
- Site Management Plan; and Site and Perimeter Air Monitoring Plan
- Onsite Assessment
- Next Community Meeting

We request that you provide the above by COB Tuesday May 16, 2017 because we would like to provide an update to the neighbors that keep inquiring about the status of the project from us.

Last but not least, we would like to have an update/check in call with all of you. Please let me know which of the following dates work for you:

- Thursday May 18, 2017 – 3:30-4:00pm
- Friday May 19, 2017 – 3:30 -4:00 pm
