#### Dilan-

I wanted to check-in prior to the upcoming meeting on March 31st, 2017, and discuss a change in schedule to the previous conditional approval for offsite assessment.

I am requesting a schedule change from the requested April 7th delivery for a soil gas investigation report to May 1st. This is due for a couple reasons:

- 1. I had misread the conditional approval and until recently thought offsite assessment required the City/County/1919crew as a prerequisite to implementation. It is now clear that is required prior to any onsite assessment approvals, not offsite.
- 2. The rains the past month have made scheduling hard to target a dates for implementation.

After reviewing with Pangea, my proposed schedule for a May 1st submittal includes:

### <u>Permits + Neighbor Permissions + Scheduling</u>

March 24th - Submit Encroachment Permit (2 weeks)

March 24th - Schedule Driller (2 weeks)

March 24th - Neighbor properties permission (1 week)

March 24th - Submit Boring Permit (1 week)

### **Total Duration = 2 weeks**

# <u>Offsite Assessment Implementation + Review</u>

April 1th -14th – Implement 10 approved locations per conditional approval

April 14th - April 21st - Data lab analysis

April 21st - May 1st - Pangea prepares Soil Gas Investigation Report

May 1st - Pangea submits to ACDEH for review.

## Total Duration = 2.5 weeks

I can assure you that the above schedule is a realistic timeframe that we can hit, and allows for

the rain season to pass prior to implementation.

I apologize for misreading the terminology of the conditional approval. If there is a problem with the proposed timeline change above, please let me know. In the meantime, we will be moving forward as shown.
