Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) has reviewed the case file including the recently submitted documents entitled *Fourth Quarter 2017 Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Report*, dated January 24, 2018, and *First Quarter 2018 Groundwater Monitoring and Sampling Report*, dated March 27, 2018. Both documents were prepared by Arcadis U.S., Inc. (Arcadis) for the subject site.

In our letter dated June 22, 2017, ACDEH presented findings of a review of the case file in conjunction with the California State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy (LTCP) and determined several general criteria (specifically b, d, e, and f) and the three media specific criteria (Groundwater, Vapor Intrusion to Indoor Air, and Direct Contact and Outdoor Air Criteria) did not appear to have been met. Based on our review, ACDEH requested preparation of a data gap investigation work plan to address these elements of the LTCP.

To date ACDEH has not received the data gap investigation work plan. However, two quarters of groundwater monitoring data has been collected since our request was made. These data may address some elements of the LTCP presented in our June 22, 2017 letter. Therefore, ACDEH requests preparation of a data gap investigation work plan in conjunction a review of the LTCP criteria. Please prepare the work plan and LTCP review and present your findings at a meeting scheduled for our offices on **Wednesday**, **July 25**, **2018** at **10 AM**.
