Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) has reviewed the recently submitted document entitled *Draft Work Plan for Soil Vapor and Investigation* provided to our agency in an electronic mail correspondence on May 31, 2017 by Almar Environmental (Almar). A precursory review of the Figure 1 attachment indicated the proposed soil vapor sample probe locations within the residential units were positioned in the center of the units.

As discussed in a phone conversation with you on Friday June 2, 2017, ACDEH staff recommended the sample points be located within the living space areas of the residential units. Almar submitted a revised figure on June 2, 2017 depicting the soil gas probes within the living space areas of the residential units. ACDEH is in general agreement with these locations.

ACDEH also recommends the addition of two additional soil probes be installed along the property line opposite School Street, along the northeast property line. Please contact me if you wish to discuss this further prior to preparing the work plan for submittal.

Thank you for your cooperation. ACDEH looks forward to working with you and your consultants to advance the case toward closure.
