Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) is considering closing the above referenced fuel case. As you are aware, site investigations and a groundwater monitoring event for hydraulic oil spill has been performed at the subject property to which you are named as the primary or active responsible party. MONITORING WELL DESTRUCTION AND WASTE REMOVAL ACTIVITIES

After public comments have been addressed, you will be requested to properly destroy the site monitoring wells and remove any remaining investigation, remediation, and well destruction derived waste from the site. ACDEH will request the well destruction in a separate letter following the conclusion of the public notification period.

REPORT & DELIVERABLE REQUESTS

SECTION: ACDEH Procedures

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the State Water Board's (SWB) GeoTracker website in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Chapter 30, Division3, Title 23 and Division 3, Title 27.

<u>Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) Cases</u>

Reports and deliverable requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party (RP) in conjunction with an unauthorized release from a petroleum underground storage tank (UST) system.

Site Cleanup Program (SCP) Cases

For non-petroleum UST cases, reports and deliverables requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 101480.

ELECTRONIC SUBMITTAL OF REPORTS

A complete report submittal includes the PDF report and all associated electronic data files, including but not limited to GEO_MAP, GEO_XY, GEO_Z, GEO_BORE, GEO_WELL, and laboratory analytical data in Electronic Deliverable Format[™] (EDF). The above referenced site is a Site Cleanup Program (SCP) case that is under the regulatory oversight of the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) for the investigation and cleanup of a release of petroleum hydrocarbons (hydraulic oil) from an elevator system that released hydraulic oil in the elevator pit sump, which ultimately flowed onto a landscaped area adjacent to the elevator tower hoistway. Site investigation and cleanup activities have been completed and it does not appear that residual contamination presents a risk to human health and the environment. Therefore, ACDEH is considering closure of the case. Due to the residual contamination on site that is unrelated to the hydraulic oil release, the site would be closed with site management requirements that require further evaluation if the site is to be redeveloped in the future.

This notice is being sent to the current occupants and landowners of adjacent properties and known interested parties for this site. The public is invited to review and comment on the potential closure of the case.
