Dear Mr. Gruendl, Mr. Zheng, and Mr. & Mrs. Poywing:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff has reviewed the case file including the *Work Plan for the Delineation of Chlorinated Solvents - Draft* (the Work Plan), prepared and submitted on behalf of BayRock PHG Piedmont, LLC (BayRock) by Cardno and received by ACDEH via email on March 16, 2018.

ACDEH understands the site is located in a mixed residential and commercial area of Oakland and consists of two parcels including Alameda County Assessor Parcel Number (APN) 12-986-25-1 located at 230 West MacArthur Boulevard and APN 12-986-28, located at 240 West MacArthur Boulevard. APN 12-986-25-1 is currently developed as an active Shell Service Station with thee underground storage tanks (USTs), two dispenser islands, and a kiosk and has operated as a fueling and auto service station since approximately the early 1950's. APN 12-986-28 is developed as an auto repair garage - Oakland AutoWorks and has historically operated as Gulf Service Station which had three 10,000-gallon USTs (removed sometime prior to 1991) and one 350-gallon waste oil UST (removed in 1996). Historical records indicate Gulf Service Station operated until the early 1950s.

ACDEH understands that BayRock is currently under contract for purchase of both parcels and intends to redevelop both parcels into a mixed-use structure with a subterranean parking garage, commercial shops at street level, and additional levels for residential use. The mixed use structure is proposed to cover nearly the entire footprint of both parcels.

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Two Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) cases are associated with the two parcels including:

- LUFT Case No. RO0000303. This case is associated with APN 12-986-25-1 and was closed by ACDEH in January 2013.
- LUFT Case No. RO0000142. This case is associated with APN 12-986-28 and is an open fuel leak case. The case was listed as inactive in December 2017 and investigation and cleanup is currently being conducted under Site Cleanup Program Case No0003259.

Until the property transaction is completed at both parcels and BayRock assumes title, the current property owners of these parcels: 12-986-25-1 owned by Xiaoyi Zheng and 12-986-28 owned by Glen and Elizabeth Poywing will be included in correspondence from ACDEH. Upon completion of the property transaction, ACDEH will administratively close LUFT Case No. RO0000142.

ACDEH understands that proposed redevelopment activities will include excavation of the upper 17 feet of soil on both properties, dewatering activities, construction of a subterranean parking area, and the installation of two proposed elevators shafts and one proposed stairwell. On March 8, 2018 ACDEH met with Stuart Gruendl from BayRock and Glen Smith from Cardno to discuss results presented in *Groundwater Monitoring Report, First Quarter 2018* dated February 19, 2018 and the proposed redevelopment activities at the Site. Results from the first quarter 2018 groundwater monitoring indicates non-petroleum related chlorinated constituents including but not limited to tetrachloroethylene (PCE), trichloroethylene (TCE), were reported in groundwater above the 2016 San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Boards (State Water Board) Environmental Screening Levels (ESLs). Non-petroleum related chlorinated constituents were reported in the vicinity of onsite locations including near the boundary between both parcels (vicinity of existing well OAW-MW4) and the western corner of the 240 MacArthur Boulevard parcel (vicinity of existing well OAW-MW1). As a result, ACDEH requested further vertical and lateral delineation of potential chemical of concern (PCOCs) on both properties to evaluate the risk to potential on- and off-site sensitive receptors and delineation of subsurface conditions near existing wells OAW-MW4 and OAW-MW1.

The proposed scope of work presented in the above-mentioned Work Plan consists of the advancement of 12 borings for collection of soil and grab groundwater samples (B4 through-B12) to include the following: 1) delineate the extent of PCOCs at the site boundaries in soil and groundwater to ensure their removal during the excavation and dewatering activities proposed during Site redevelopment and 2) delineation of subsurface PCOCs reported near existing wells OAW-MW4 and OAW-MW1.

Based on our review, ACDEH approves the Work Plan and requests that you, perform the proposed work and submit the requested *Deliverables* to the State Water Resources Control Board's GeoTracker website in accordance with the compliance schedule provided below and the *Responsible Party (ies) Legal Requirement/Obligations Instructions* and *File Naming Conventions* which are included as Attachments 1 and 2 respectively. ACDEH requests email notification verifying the requested deliverables have been uploaded to Geotracker (e-mail preferred to: andrew.york@acgov.org).

Please submit the following deliverables according to the following schedule:

- 1. <u>Subsurface Investigation Report</u> A technical report documenting the results of the scope of work presented in the approved Work Plan mentioned above.

Alternatively, subsurface investigation results may be incorporated into the submittal of the Remedial Action Plan.

#### REPORT & DELIVERABLE REQUESTS

**SECTION:** ACDEH Procedures

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Cleanup Oversight Programs, Local Oversight Program (LOP) and Site Cleanup Program (SCP) require submission of all reports in electronic form to the State Water Board's (SWB) GeoTracker website in accordance with California Code of Regulations, Chapter 30, Division3, Title 23 and Division 3, Title 27.

### <u>Leaking Underground Fuel Tank (LUFT) Cases</u>

Reports and deliverable requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 25296.10. 23 CCR Sections 2652 through 2654, and 2721 through 2728 outline the responsibilities of a responsible party (RP) in conjunction with an unauthorized release from a petroleum underground storage tank (UST) system.

#### Site Cleanup Program (SCP) Cases

For non-petroleum UST cases, reports and deliverables requests are pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 101480.

A complete report submittal includes the PDF report and all associated electronic data files, including but not limited to GEO\_MAP, GEO\_XY, GEO\_Z, GEO\_BORE, GEO\_WELL, and laboratory analytical data in Electronic Deliverable Format™ (EDF). 
