This provides written notice that Alameda County Department of Environmental Health has received a request and intends to enter into a Voluntary Remedial Action Agreement with the responsible party pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 101480 in approximately 10 working days.

- (c) The Voluntary Remedial Action Agreement will apply to 16500 – 16550 Ashland Ave and 205 & 255 Ano, San Lorenzo, CA
- (d) The purpose of the Remedial Action Agreement will be to investigate the extent of soil and groundwater contamination as a result of a release(s) from a gasoline station. Site is under contract and a mixed commercial/residential redevelopment is proposed.
