Dear Ms. Chesick:

Anania Geologic Engineering (AGE) requests permission to abandon eleven more wells at the Oakland Dairy facility located at 1310 14th Street in Oakland, California. Included in this set are eight product recovery points and three vapor recovery wells designated as PR-10, PR-74, PR-78, PR-79, PR-89, PR-90, PR-98, PR-100, V-26, V-27, and V-56. The wells to be abandoned are highlighted in yellow on the enclosed map. To date, 23 wells have been abandoned at the site. One well, MW-21 is permitted for abandonment and is scheduled to be abandoned on May 9, 1990. For your reference, the abandoned wells, including MW-21 are highlighted in green.

The product recovery points will be abandoned by over drilling the well to a depth of one foot below the casing and backfilling the hole with concrete using a tremie pipe. In the case of the vapor recovery wells, the wells will be drilled to the base of the casing and then backfilled with concrete using a tremie pipe. The vapor recovery wells will not be drilled below the casing because the wells are set just above groundwater. Complete abandonment above the groundwater surface is preferred to reduce the potential for further contamination of the groundwater.

AGE would like to abandon these wells beginning the week of May 21, 1990 if possible. Once AGE receives your approval, an abandonment permit from Zone 7 will be obtained. I will contact you early next
