As we discussed last week, this letter serves to confirm our scheduled meeting with Ms. Donna Drogos and you at 10:00 am on March 19, 2009 regarding the site referenced above. Mr. Ray Plock and I will attend the meeting on behalf of The Pepsi Bottling Group, Inc. (PBG). The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the site investigation requests presented in your letter dated November 5, 2008 and which was addressed to PBG, New Century Beverages and Kaiser Foundation Hospitals. We agreed that PBG will not perform the tasks requested by your agency's letter before the March 19 meeting.

During recent visits to the site, Mr. Plock and I observed that the *eastern* portion of the former Pepsi property is being prepared for construction. The former underground fuel tanks and the petroleum hydrocarbon-impacted soil and groundwater were located beneath the *western* portion of the former Pepsi property, which is currently a fenced and paved parking lot owned by the Pixar Animation Studios. Thus, it does not appear that the current construction will encounter soil or groundwater that had been impacted by the former fuel tanks.
