On behalf of the Douglas Parking Company, Pangea Environmental Services, Inc. (Pangea) has prepared this *Well Destruction Report* (Report) for the subject site. Well destruction was requested by Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) during a meeting on October 6, 2017. Email correspondence with ACDEH regarding the well destruction is included in Appendix A. This Report documents the destruction of twelve groundwater monitoring, air sparge, and soil gas wells at the site.

WELL DESTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

On October 26, 2017, Pangea coordinated the destruction of wells MW-1, MW-2, MW-3, MW-4, MW-5, MW-6, MW-7, AS-1, AS-2, AS-3, SG-1, and SG-2 by pressure grouting. Well construction details are shown on Table A. Figure 1 shows the site location. Figure 2 shows the destroyed well locations.

A comprehensive Site Safety Plan was prepared to protect site workers, and the plan was kept onsite during all field activities. Well destruction permits were obtained from Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA). Obstruction and excavation permits were obtained from the City of Oakland. All permits were kept onsite for the duration of well destruction activities. Copies of the permits are presented in Appendix B. The proposed drilling locations were marked and Underground Service Alert was notified at least 72 hours before the proposed field activities.

Pangea retained Confluence Drilling (Confluence) of Rio Linda, California, to conduct well destruction activities. Prior to pressure grouting, all wells were gauged for total well depth. No well proposed for destruction contained 2 ft or more of fill/sediment within the bottom of the well casing prior to destruction. A casing extension was placed on the top of the well to allow collection of displaced groundwater. Portland cement was placed into the well through a tremie pipe positioned at the bottom of the well. After the well was filled with cement, a well cap fitted with a pressure gauge and water-tight fitting was attached to the top of the well casing. Cement grout was pumped through the cap and into the well until the pressure gauge reached and maintained at least 25 pounds per square inch (psi) for five minutes. The well box ring was removed and the well box was repaved with concrete and/or asphalt to match the existing surface.


