Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) prepared and submitted to Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) an *Oxygen Injection Work Plan* (work plan), dated August 13, 2008, on behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron) for the site referenced above. In the work plan, bi-weekly oxygen injection events in well MW-5 were proposed to attempt to reduce residual petroleum hydrocarbon concentrations in this well via enhanced biodegradation. More than 60 calendar days have passed since submittal of the work plan and to date CRA has not received correspondence from ACEH regarding the proposed scope of work.
