### Mr. Beretta:

On March 19<sup>th</sup>, I sent an email to your attorney with the access agreement prepared by your attorney attached. Dear Mr. Beretta,

As discussed in the February 24, 2015 meeting with representatives of Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH), Antea Group USA, Inc. (Antea), Pacific Convenience and Fuel (PC&F), and Beretta Investment Group (BIG), ACEH agreed to the destruction of the two groundwater monitoring wells located on your property adjacent to the 76 Station located at 449 Hegenberger Road in Oakland, CA. Also discussed were the two methods of well destruction- over-drilling and pressure grouting- allowed under regulation. The selected method would be acceptable to you as the property owner. A review of the meeting notes indicates you were to review the destruction methods and reply with the selected method.

ACEH has not been contacted with your selected method of well destruction. ACEH has recently reviewed the Antea work plan for the well destructions. The Antea work plan identifies the well destruction method as over-drilling the wells.

Prior to approving the work plan, ACEH wishes to confirm that the over-drill method is your method of choice for well destruction. Please contact ACEH (Attention: Keith Nowell), via email correspondence, identifying which of the two well destruction methods you have selected. ACEH request you respond to ACEH by **April 24, 2015**.
