A few months ago (February 13, 2009), you prepared a letter to the responsible party for this environmental case (Moller Investment Group, formerly USA Gasoline Corporation) that requested a work plan for a pilot study or a Draft Corrective Action Plan be submitted by April 17, 2009.

The owner of the property for this site (Jay-Phares Corporation) is in the process of planning redevelopment of the subject property. Stratus Environmental, Inc. and the responsible party were planning to meet with Jay-Phares in approximately 2 weeks in order to obtain as much information as possible regarding redevelopment in the area where the the subsurface contamination is present. The type of development that will occur in this portion of the property will have a large influence upon selecting the best remedial approach to address the contamination issue in this area.

Stratus is asking that the deadline for submittal of the pilot study work plan or Draft Corrective Action Plan document be extended from April 17th to May 29th, 2009. Extension of the deadline will allow us to incorporate information obtained from the upcoming meeting into the document, and allow us to make a better recommendation regarding a remedial approach that will

enable cleanup of contaminants and work within the constraints of the property redevelopment.
