Per your request, I'm forwarding the following specific comments regarding the "Background Review and Workplan for Subsurface Environmental Investigations" dated March 24, 1997, prepared and submitted by Erler & Kalinowski, Inc. for the South Bayfront project in Emeryville, California.

1) Page 27, last paragraph. The Underground Storage Tank Unauthorized Leak / Contamination Site Report was for the removal of **two** (not one) 1,000 - gallon USTs.

2) Page 28, second paragraph. Concentrations of total xylenes detected in the samples of soil ranged from 1.74 mg/kg to 1,840 mg/kg (not 0.87 mg/kg to 920 mg/kg).

3) Page 30, third paragraph. Change benzene (maximum concentration of 9,100 mg/l) to 9.1 mg/l.

4) Page 32, last paragraph. Three groundwater sampling events (10/13/89, 2/2/93 and 6/30/93) have been conducted on wells MW-1, MW-2 and MW-3. Table 3-2 needs to be revised. Groundwater data for the three sampling events is enclosed.

MEETING REGARDING REDEVELOPMENT AND CLEANUP OF SOUTH BAYFRONT RETAIL SITE, SHELLMOUND, STREET, EMERYVILLE

As you may be aware, the Department of Toxic Substances (Department) is currently involved in oversight of investigations at several sites located along Shellmound Street in Emeryville. Through our involvement with the sites, the Department has found that similar types of contaminants are found in the groundwater and that groundwater is generally moving in a westward direction. Discussions with the City of Emeryville's Redevelopment Agency (Agency) have also revealed that the Agency has plans to redevelop the area into a regional shopping center. This office received and reviewed a Groundwater Sampling Report dated June 30, 1993 (and received October 7, 1993) by Blaine Tech Services. The following are comments concerning this report:

- 1. There is no evaluation or recommendations in this report. It is basically just laboratory analysis. Attached find an outline of information that is needed for this case to be closed.
- 2. There also should be site maps showing location of wells and calculated groundwater gradient. This had to be researched in reports that were 4 years old. Blaine Tech Services says on page 1 of the report all the services they do not perform. And yet, someone needs to do them. There are levels of TPHg of 450 ppb, TPHd of 2,700 ppb, and benzene at 100 ppb. All three wells show contamination. Please submit a recommendation for what you intend to do. At this point, consistent quarterly monitoring may be a viable proposal.

Thank you for your letter of 11/17/92 re. the above property. Please allow me to respond on behalf of my Grandfather, Mr. A.M. Sepulveda, property owner. My Grandfather is 85 years of age and has asked my assistance in this matter.

The soil excavated in response to gasoline contamination discovered during a routine gasoline UST removal in 1989 was manifested, shipped to and landfilled at Chemical Waste Management's Class 1 facility at Kettlemen Hills, CA. We are in the process of researching the file to document this activity for you. All of the excavated soil required by Alameda County DHS (Dennis Byrne), was shipped at that time. No excavated contaminated soil remains at the property.

No further investigation has been performed at the site. Mr. Sepulveda was informed by Alameda County DHS that core contamination had been removed and that the excavation area could be backfilled and restored. DHS did require the installation of the three groundwater monitoring wells. Records are being researched at this time for analytical data from those wells.

Pursuant to your point #3 we propose, with your approval, to contract an independent sampling and testing company (Blaine Tech Services, San Jose, CA), to properly sample and have analyzed groundwater from the three wells. This program would be on a quarterly frequency checking the samples for BTEX gasoline. We assume you would require copies of test results as they develop. We will forward the results as they are received.

With your approval we would like to sample the wells 12/92; 3/93; 6/93; and 9/93 to meet the four quarter ND requirement. We recognize that the program may have to continue if ND results are not forthcoming.

We hope the above will satisfy the requirements you outlined. Please contact me direct @ (510) 253-0591, 55 Oak Dr., Orinda, CA, 94563 if you have any questions. Thank you again for your consideration.

This office has received and reviewed the Draft Soil & Ground-Water Investigation Report by Harding Lawson Associates (HLA) dated October 13, 1989, and a followup report dated January 12, 1990 concerning the above site. The following comments are to be considered:

- 1. There conclusions in the above report said the stockpiled soil would be classified as hazardous waste for disposal. Please submit documentation for the disposition of the soil stockpile to this office within 30 days.
- 2. HLA recommended further investigation be done, to better define on-site contamination and to look for possible off-site sources that may be contributing. This office has no record of any further investigation to date.
- 3. The Regional Water Quality Control Board would require at least 4 quarters of groundwater monitoring at ND. No monitoring has apparently been done for the 3 installed wells on your site since about October 1989. You must implement a groundwater monitoring program within 30 days.

Soil Sampling and Analysis 5600 Shellmound Emeryville, California

This letter by Harding Lawson Associates (HLA) presents observations and results of chemical analysis for a soil sample obtained December 22, 1989 at A & J Trucking property, 5600 Shellmound, Emeryville, California.

This soil sample (NW-1A) was obtained by Mr. Ken McQuaid, agent for A & J Trucking, under the supervision of an HLA field geologist. NW-1A was obtained approximately one foot above the ground-water surface at the same location as NW-1 of a previous site investigation (Plate 1). NW-1A was a relatively undisturbed sample obtained by driving a 2-1/2-inch-diameter stainless steel tube into the wall of the former tank pit, capping the tube with aluminum foil and plastic end caps, and sealing it with adhesive tape. This sample was subsequently placed in an ice-chilled cooler and delivered under chain-of-custody documentation to a state-certified laboratory for analysis.

NW-1 was analyzed for the presence of TPH as gasoline and fuel constituents (benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes [BTEX]), using EPA Test Methods 8015 and 8020. Results of analyses indicated no TPH as gasoline or BTEX, as documented on the attached laboratory report.

On behalf of Mr. Arthur M. Sepulveda, and at your request, I recently arranged for an additional soil sample to be taken from the excavation site located at 5600 Shellmound Ave., Emeryville, CA. The results of the analyses performed with a cover letter forwarded to me by Harding Lawson Associates are enclosed for your inspection.

Following our recent telephone conversation during which you stated there was no need for further excavation and that the existing hole could be refilled and returned to its former condition, Mr. Sepulveda and I have made tentative arrangements with various contractors to dispose of the excavated soil, refill and compact the site with fresh fill, and to reconcrete the opening. As we discussed, I am hopeful your review of the enclosed hard-copy documents will result in your formal recommendation to proceed with these tentative plans.


With respect to the investigation to quantify the extent of a possible contamination plume in surrounding groundwater, I am making arrangements to have MW-3 (plate 2 of site plan) resampled and analyzed. Proposals have been solicited from various consulting firms to provide a site history evaluation, given the rather extensive history of surrounding property contamination sources. Also, proposals have been solicited to provide samples and analysis of groundwater taken from the far Northwestern corner of the property. I will continue to keep you apprised of our progress in this area.

As Mr. Sepulveda would like to proceed with the aforementioned restoration work as soon as possible, and since we feel compelled to take no action without your formal recommendation, may we respectfully thank you in advance for your consideration and cooperation.

We are in receipt of your letter of December 7, 1989, regarding the continuing clean-up of the site located at 5600 Shellmound Avenue in Emeryville. Your letter confirms your earlier notification that you wished to proceed on this project without Scott Co. As of your earlier request on October 31, 1989, Scott Co. has removed its personnel and equipment from the site and discontinued its participation in this project. Scott Co. disclaims any responsibility after that date for work on the site, transportation and disposition of materials from the site, or dealing with regulatory agencies. To the extent that Scott Co.'s former subcontractors on the project, such as Harding Lawson Associates, wish to work with you on the project, they are free to do so under whatever arrangements they wish to make with you. As we have discussed, Scott Co. has no liability for payments to any such subcontractors incurred after the date of Scott's departure from the project.

By copy of this letter to the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency, Department of Environmental Health, Hazardous Materials Division, and any other appropriate governmental agencies, we are notifying them of Scott Co.'s departure from the site and termination of Scott Co.'s responsibilities with respect to the project as of October 31, 1989, at your request. You may find it advisable to check into any permits or filings, or modification of earlier permits and filings, that may be needed for the continuation of the project without Scott Co.'s participation.

With respect to restoration of the site upon the conclusion of the work you have undertaken by other means, Scott Co. remains willing to carry out its obligation to fill in where the tanks were located. However, as you are aware, at your request a significant amount of additional contaminated soil on the site was removed, which was not part of the original proposal. If you wish Scott Co. to fill the hole left by the removal of the extra contaminated soil, additional compensation will be necessary. Please let us know how you wish to proceed.



- 4. All soil is to be placed on visquene and covered up at the end of each day to minimize any aeration that might take place until the quantity of contaminated soil is known.
