

Alameda County Environmental Health, Local Oversight Program (LOP) staff has received and reviewed the June 17, 2003 Workplan to Conduct Soil and Groundwater Investigation for the referenced site prepared by Gribi Associates. The work plan proposes the installation of two temporary wells, the collection of a soil sample from each of these wells and the sampling and analysis of groundwater from the new and existing well for the analytes, TPHg, BTEX and MTBE. Groundwater flow direction should then be determined. Our office approves this work plan, however, please also address the following technical comments.

Technical Comments

- 1. Soil from each of the borings shall be screened using a field instrument. The soil sample collected for analysis shall be from the depth, which exhibits the greatest field screen reading or from the capillary fringe if no petroleum contamination is observed.
- 2. Should MTBE be detected in any soil or groundwater sample, its presence shall be confirmed using EPA Method 8260.
- 3. The groundwater sample from MW-1 shall additionally be analyzed for the other ether oxygenates (TAME, ETBE, DIPE and TBA) and the lead scavengers, EDB and EDC.

Alameda County Environmental Health, Local Oversight Program (LOP) staff has reviewed the case file for the referenced site and considered your request for case closure. We have determined that additional information is needed before we can recommend your site for closure. Please address the following technical comments and submit the technical report requested below.

Technical Comments

- 1. The groundwater gradient has not been determined at the site, therefore, the location of the lone well, MW-1, may not represent the highest nor down-gradient contaminant concentration.
- The extent of the petroleum contamination is groundwater has not been adequately determined.
 The grab groundwater sample from boring IB-1 reported 26,000 ppb Total Petroleum
 Hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) and the most recent 9/99 sampling of MW-1 reported 6,000 ppb TPHg.
- 3. The levels of TPHg in the shallow groundwater (<10' below ground surface), may pose an odor problem if residential use of this property occurred. Therefore, additional investigation and/or remediation is necessary before we can close this site for unrestricted land use.

Technical Report Request

Please submit the following technical report according to the following schedule.

July 9, 2003- Work plan to re-sample MW-1 and delineate the extent of petroleum contamination in groundwater. If necessary, provide a work plan to determine site-specific groundwater gradient.

Dear Mr. Houston and Ms. Berkeley:

In August 1998 one exploratory boring and one groundwater monitoring well were drilled at the above referenced site. Soil and groundwater samples were collected from each boring. Up to 26,000 parts per billion total petroleum hydrocarbons were detected in groundwater. A letter, dated November 23, 1998, from this Agency requested that quarterly groundwater monitoring be implemented for well MW-1W. To date we have not received a quarterly monitoring report (QMR) from you.

Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations (23CCR), Section 2652(d), requires the owner or operator of an UST facility to submit reports every three months, or at a more frequent interval as specified by the local agency or regional water board, until investigation and cleanup are complete

At this time, you must reinstate a quarterly schedule of well sampling and monitoring. Technical summary reports documenting each well sampling and monitoring episode are also due quarterly. This schedule shall continue until further notice.

Dear Mr. Houston, Ms. Berkeley and Ms. Fisher:

I have completed review of Gribi Associates' November 4, 1998 Report of Soil and Groundwater Investigation report prepared for the above referenced site. This report summarized the recent work performed to collect soil and water samples from two hand-augured borings. Analytical results revealed moderate levels of total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) and low levels of benzene, toluene, ethyl-benzene, and xylenes (BTEX) in soil and groundwater.

At this time you should continue to sample groundwater monitoring well MW-1W on a quarterly basis. Groundwater should be analyzed for TPHg and BTEX. Data from the subsequent sampling events will verify contaminant concentrations over any seasonal fluctuations in groundwater elevation. If concentration levels continue to remain stable or decrease, I will review the case for possible closure.

Dear Mr. Houston, Ms. Berkeley and Ms. Fisher:

I am currently the case worker overseeing site cleanup of the former leaking underground storage tank (UST) at the above referenced site (aka 733 Apgar Street). A 550 gallon UST for the storage of gasoline was removed in January 1992. Obvious petroleum odors from and stained soil within the excavation were noted. Soil and groundwater samples were collected from the pit and analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), benzene, toluene, ethyl-benzene, and xylenes (BTEX). Analytical results identified up to 16,000 parts per billion (ppb) TPHg and 420 ppb xylenes in groundwater.

Before closure can be considered for this site, a groundwater investigation is needed. In order to proceed with this site investigation, you should obtain the professional services of a reputable environmental consultant. Your responsibility is to have the consultant submit for review a proposal or work plan that outlines planned activities for determining the extent and severity of soil and groundwater contamination at the site. The investigation can be performed by using direct push methods to collect soil and groundwater samples at the vicinity of the former UST. The samples should be analyzed for TPHg and BTEX.

The work plan is due within 60 days of the date of this letter, or by August 30, 1998. Be advised that this letter constitutes a formal request for technical reports pursuant to the California Water Code, Section 13267(b).
