I have completed review of the case file for the above referenced site for possible closure. At this time, case closure cannot be granted because of the elevated Methyl Tertiary-Butly Ether (MTBE) concentrations still present in groundwater monitoring well MW-1. However, because other chemicals of concern are not present at levels which would pose a risk to human health, the sampling frequency of well MW-1 may be reduced to a semi-annual basis. Groundwater should be sampled in June and December of each year and analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), and MTBE. At this time, you may discontinue the sampling of well MW-2.

Be advised that the closure decision is subject to appeal to the Manager of the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund, pursuant to Section 25299.39.2(b) of the Health and Safety Code (Thompson-Richter Underground Storage Tank Reform Act – Senate Bill 562). Please contact the Fund at (800) 813-FUND for information regarding the appeal process.

As requested and discussed, Horizon Environmental Inc. (Horizon) is forwarding this letter describing the soil conditions evaluated beneath the former dispenser at the above-referenced site. The dispenser and associated underground storage tank (UST) were removed in May 1996. Former locations of the USTs, and dispenser along with other selected site features are shown on the Site Plan included with this letter.

According to the Underground Storage Tank Closure Report (Blymer Engineering, Inc. 1995), following removal of the dispenser, a dispenser island soil sample was collected from approximately 3 inches below grade surface. This soil sample was analyzed for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) and the hydrocarbon constituents benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX). Laboratory results indicated BTEX concentrations in concentrations ranging from 100 to 1,300 parts per million (ppm) and TPHg concentrations at 46,000 ppm. Based on these concentrations, Alameda County Health Care Services requested that this area be investigated further during the next phase of investigation.

During the next phase of subsurface investigative work (July 1996), a hole was cut in the concrete floor adjacent to the western edge of the concrete pad of the former dispenser (Figure 2). A Horizon geologist then proceeded to drill a hand auger boring through the hole at this location (SB-1). According to the geologist, no subjective evidence of hydrocarbons was present and the soil was native (silty clay) from approximately 6-inches below the slab to the total depth of the boring. Soil samples were collected from the hand auger boring at depths of 5 and 7 feet bsg. Saturated soil was encountered at 8 feet bsg. Each of the collected samples were analyzed for TPHg, BTEX, and MTBE. No detectable concentrations of the gasoline constituents analyzed for were detected in the samples. This data along with copies of the laboratory reports was reported in Horizon's Preliminary Subsurface Assessment Report dated November 11, 1996.

It is Horizon's opinion that the gasoline hydrocarbons initially discovered at 3-inches bsg at the former dispenser location was most likely within the product line trench backfill beneath the floor of the building and does not extend into native soil. Therefore we do not foresee the need for future investigation or concern for hydrocarbon-impacted soil beneath the building at this location.





I have completed review of Horizon Environmental Inc's November 1996 Monitoring Well Completion and Preliminary Subsurface Assessment Report for the above referenced site. This report summarized the well installation, hand-augered boring and sampling activities performed in July 1996. Analytical results of soil and groundwater samples collected suggest that the fuel and waste oil release from the former underground storage tanks was limited in extent and severity.

At this time you should implement a quarterly monitoring schedule for wells MW-1 and MW-2. Groundwater should be analyzed for the same constituents as in July 1996. However, analysis for MTBE (as well as TPHg and BTEX) from well MW-1 should be conducted using EPA Method 8260 to verify the correct identification of

Workplan Approval for 1650 Park Street, Alameda, CA 94501 RE:

Dear Ms. Ball and Ms. Nokes:

I have completed review of Horizon Environmental Inc's March 1996 Work Plan for a Subsurface Investigation at the above referenced The workplan proposes to install monitoring wells downgradient from the former waste oil and gasoline tanks. proposed is a hand auger to 10' depth along the former dispenser The workplan is acceptable with the following recommendations and/or additions.

If groundwater flow direction beneath the adjacent site is interpreted to be toward the north-northeast, then the proposed wells should be located north-northeast of the former tanks (not north-northwest as indicated on the site plan). Also, the hand auger should be advanced through the former pump island, if possible, to delineate the vertical extent of soil contamination. At the same time this may remove additional hydrocarbon-impacted soils (up to 46,000 ppm TPHg and 1,300 ppm benzene was detected at 0.25'). Soil samples collected from boring MW-1 and from the hand augered boring should also be quantified for MTBE.

Dear Ms. Ball and Ms. Nokes:

A 550 gallon gasoline and a 255 gallon waste oil underground storage tank (UST) were removed on August 10, 1995 from the above referenced site. Soil samples collected from native soil beneath the gasoline UST at 8' depth detected up to 7,100 parts per million total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (ppm TPH-G) and 36 ppm benzene. Soil beneath the gasoline dispenser detected 46,000 ppm TPH-G and 1,300 ppm benzene. Soil from beneath the waste oil tank at 6.5' depth detected 3,100 ppm total oil and grease.

Clearly, an unauthorized release of fuel products have occurred from the use of the former USTs. At this time, additional investigations are required to delineate the extent and severity of soil and possibly groundwater contamination at the site. Such an investigation shall be in the form of a **Preliminary Site**Assessment, or PSA. The information gathered by the PSA will be used to determine an appropriate course of action to remediate the site, if deemed necessary. The PSA must be conducted in accordance with the RWQCB Staff Recommendations for the Initial Evaluation and Investigation of Underground Tanks, and Article 11 of Title 23, California Code of Regulations. The major elements of such an investigation are summarized in the attached Appendix A.

The PSA proposal is due within 45 days of the date of this letter. Once the proposal is approved, field work should commence within 60 days. A report must be submitted within 45 days after the completion of this phase of work at the site. Subsequent reports are to be submitted <u>quarterly</u> until this site qualifies for RWQCB "sign off." All reports and proposals must be submitted under seal of a California Registered Geologist, Certified Engineering Geologist, or Registered Civil Engineer.


