Re: Proposed Well-Point Survey for Chevron Station No. 9-0121 located at 3026 Lakeshore Avenue, Oakland, California

Dear Mr. Chan:

Groundwater Technology Inc. has received your letter dated July 23, 1990, and based on your request, Groundwater Technology has included additional well-point locations for the above-referenced survey. These locations are intended to assess the possible occurrence of dissolved-gasoline hydrocarbons from an off-site source to the north, and to provide further definition of the on-site plume. The latest round of sampling at this site showed nondetectable levels of gasoline hydrocarbons in a well located along the southern edge of the site, east of the station building. Therefore, no well points are proposed south of the site. The presence of buildings to the west of the site will prevent the sampling of the groundwater adjacent to the site in that direction.

Please note that all the marked locations are only proposed tentative locations. Actual placement of the well points will be determined by site conditions, the availability of encroachment permits, the presence of underground utilities, and the evidence Mr. Barney Chan August 9, 1990 Page 2

gathered from previous sample locations. After field work is completed, Groundwater Technology will prepare a report detailing the results and findings of this investigation. Copies of all future reports regarding this site will also be submitted.
