This email is to inform you that the Feasibility Study for ARCO Station 601 at 712 Lewelling Blvd in San Leandro (ACEH Case RO309) was not submitted by the 4/12 due date as you requested. BAI underestimated the effects of recent changes BP made to its Health, Safety, Security & Environment (HSSE) procedures, namely the involvement of other entities in the review of plans that lead to designing systems for remediation such as a DPE. BAI humbly requests a 30 day extension to implement the necessary procedures for review and oversight.
