This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during October 1992, and site activities anticipated for the month of November 1992.

## October 1992 Activities

- O Performed groundwater monitoring and monthly product removal from wells MW-1, MW-3, and MW-5.
- O Continued with design and preparation of plans and specifications for a groundwater remediation system at the site.
- Drilled five onsite soil borings and installed two groundwater monitoring wells.
- O Drilled and sampled 10 offsite soil borings along Lewelling Boulevard for information pertained to PG&E trenching to be performed at the site.

## Work Anticipated for November 1992

- O Continue monthly groundwater monitoring.
- Monthly removal of floating product will continue.
- O Continue with design and preparation of plans and specifications for a groundwater remediation system at the site.
- O Continue with attempts to gain offsite access from private owners to install offsite monitoring wells.
- O Drill and install one offsite groundwater monitoring well across Washington Avenue from the site.
- Initiate preparation of draft Additional Onsite Subsurface Investigation Report including onsite borings and wells.
- Initiate preparation of draft Offsite Subsurface Investigation Report including the soil borings along Lewelling Boulevard.
