RGA Environmental, Inc. (RGA) is pleased to present this work plan addendum for the Subsurface Investigation Work Plan dated July 16, 2002 for the subject site. In accordance with your July 18, 2002 fax transmittal, the number of boreholes has been increased from five to six, and the locations of the boreholes have been amended as shown on the attached Site Plan, Figure 2. Borehole drilling and sample collection procedures will be as set forth in the July 16, 2002 work plan.

In addition, one soil sample will be collected at a depth of three feet below the ground surface from each of boreholes B1, B2 and B3. The samples will be collected into a brass tube using a slide hammer and a stainless steel sampler. All sampling equipment will be cleaned with an Alconox solution followed by a clean water rinse prior to use in each borehole. The brass tube will be completely filled to eliminate any head space. The ends of the tube will be covered sequentially with aluminum foil and plastic endcaps. After labeling, the tubes will be stored in a cooler with ice pending delivery to McCampbell Analytical, Inc. Chain of custody procedures will be observed for all sample handling. The samples will be analyzed as follows.

- o 3 borehole soil samples (B1 through B3) for TPH Multi Range (Gas, Diesel and Oil),
- o 3 borehole soil samples (B1 through B3) for BTEX/MTBE by EPA 8020.

In all soil samples where MTBE is detected, MTBE confirmation analysis will be performed using EPA Method 8260.



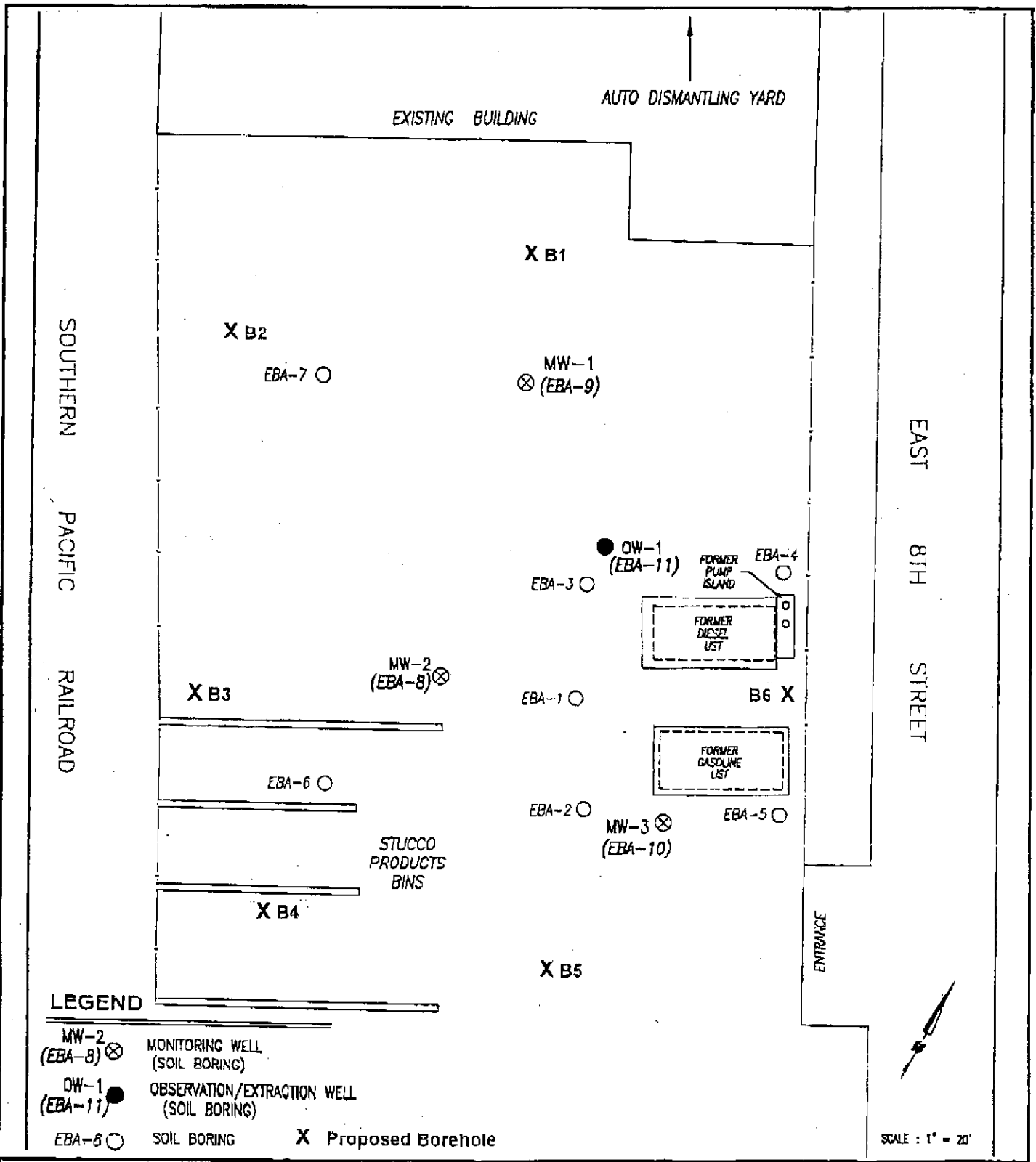


FIGURE 2
