PROJECT SUMMARY

At the request of Shell Oil Company, GeoStrategies Inc.(GSI) conducted a Preliminary Site Assessment of the property located at 461 8th Street in Oakland, California. The assessment included: a physical site inspection of the property and surrounding area, interviews with persons knowledgeable of the subject site, and a review of Federal, State, and local records, and associated research. Based on GSI's investigation, the following issues of environmental concern were identified:

- The subject property was a gasoline service station from 1965 to 1980. Galvanized steel product piping failed pressure integrity testing, and was removed in 1979. In May 1980, Shell Oil Company terminated their lease of the subject property and removed all existing improvements, buildings, and underground storage tanks (UST).
- Known hydrocarbon contamination is present in the soil and groundwater immediately adjacent to the subject property.
- Regulatory agency file review revealed the presence of seven Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) sites within one quarter mile of the subject property.

No other problems of significant environmental concern were discovered during the course of this investigation.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

GeoStrategies Inc (GSI) was retained by Shell Oil Company to conduct a Preliminary Environmental Site Assessment (PSA) of the ALLRIGHT PARKING Lot site, a former Shell service station, located at 461 8th Street, Oakland, Alameda County, California The purpose of the PSA is to assess the potential environmental concerns of past and present activities and current conditions at the subject property. Mr. Chuck Headlee, Regulatory Compliance Manager performed the site assessment on June 21, 1993. Findings of the report are discussed in Section 7.0 and recommendations for further actions are provided in Section 8.0.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work included the following tasks:

TASK 1: On Site Investigation and Off-Site Reconnaissance

GSI performed a site inspection and an off-site reconnaissance. The off-site reconnaissance distance was approximately 1/4-mile from the existing property boundary. The purpose of this task was to visually identify potential sources of contamination which may have impacted the site. Past tenants were not available for questioning during this course of this investigation.

TASK 2: Literature/Records Search

GSI reviewed existing public domain records and files to assess whether present or past generation, use, storage, or disposal of hazardous materials had or potentially could have affected site conditions. GSI reviewed public records and correlate research data with our site inspection and off-site reconnaissance findings.

TASK 3: Aerial Photograph Survey and Map Survey

GSI reviewed aerial photographs, topographic maps and Sanborn maps to evaluate changes in the physical setting and historical land use of the subject property and adjoining properties.

TASK 4: Computer Database Search

GSI reviewed pertinent computer databases maintained by State and Federal agencies to evaluate known or suspected contaminated sites which may have impacted the subject property.

TASK 5: Report Preparation

GSI prepared this written report discussing the results of the Phase I PSA. The report, contains our conclusions and recommendations as well as representative photographs of the subject property.

3.0 SITE LOCATION AND JURISDICTION

The subject property is located at 461 8th Street, Oakland, Alameda County, California (Appendix 10.3, Figure 1). The property consists of approximately 16,000 square feet of land and is improved as a public parking lot. The entire property is paved with asphalt, and no structures exist on the site (Appendix 10.2, Plate 1). The subject property is located in a completely developed area (zoned C-52,S-7/S-8) of mixed commercial use. The site is in the redevelopment area known as Old Oakland and is bounded by retail shops, restaurants, offices, abandoned buildings, and vacant lots. The Oakland Estuary is approximately 0.5 miles to the west. Interstate Highway 880 lies 500 feet to the west of the subject property.

4.0 SITE HISTORY, PRESENT AND PROPOSED USES

4.1 Current and Past Tenant Uses

The subject property is owned by the Weston Havens Trust and managed by Pacific Property Asset Management Company. Real estate title records were not readily available during the course of this PSA.

According to Sanborn maps reviewed by GSI, the site has been used for various retail and restaurant facilities from 1889 until at least 1952. Oakland Building Department records indicate that American Oil Company built a service station on the subject property in 1965. According to permits issued by the City of Oakland Engineering Department, in 1974 Shell Oil Company installed vapor recovery piping at the facility to meet existing air quality guidelines. The site was in continuous use as a service station from 1965 until 1960 when Shell Oil Company terminated their lease, removed the tanks and piping, and demolished the service station building. The site has been used as a parking lot since the demolition.

4.2 Aerial Photograph Survey

GSI reviewed aerial photographs from the years 1947, 1950, 1953, 1959, 1971, 1975, 1979, 1983, and 1992. Photos were reviewed for site conditions, surrounding land uses, and evidence of environmental concerns.

1947 Aerial Photograph

The subject property and all surrounding areas appear to be used for residential or retail commercial. The subject site is visible as a small

residential or commercial facility. There is no visible evidence of any industrial activity at the subject property or in the surrounding area. Railroad tracks running northwest to southeast are visible approximately three eighths of a mile southwest of the site. The Oakland Estuary, part of San Francisco Bay, is seen approximately one half mile to the west of the subject property. Lake Merritt appears approximately one mile to the northeast of the subject property.

1950 - 1959 Aerial Photographs

The subject property and all surrounding areas appear to be used for residential or retail commercial. The subject site is visible as a small residential or commercial facility. There is no visible evidence of any industrial activity at the subject property or in the surrounding area. Large natural gas storage containers are visible one half mile to the west of the subject property. Increased development of the Port of Oakland property at the Oakland Estuary west and northwest of the site is evident. There is no visible evidence of any manufacturing or industrial activity in the nearby area of the subject property. Interstate 880 (then referred to as State Highway 17) is visible to the west of the subject property.

1971 Aerial Photograph

The subject property is visible as a service station. The surrounding properties are a mix of retail commercial, or residential uses. The Port of Oakland facilities are more developed with cargo terminals visible in the photo. The area near the port facilities are visible as either industrial or heavy commercial properties. The area west of the subject property, near the railroad tracks, is developed as a produce distribution center. Between the produce district and the Estuary restaurants and nightclubs

are visible.

1975 - 1979 Aerial Photographs

The subject property is occupied by what appears to be a gasoline service station. The surrounding area appears to be undergoing redevelopment, but is still predominantly retail commercial or residential. Within a quarter mile of the subject property at least two facilities are visible that appear to be service stations or auto repair shops. Large natural gas storage tanks, associated with the Port of Oakland, are visible along with the Port of Oakland property to the northwest.

1983 Aerial Photograph

The subject property is visible as an empty lot surrounded by retail commercial properties and other vacant lots. The area appears to be undergoing redevelopment from old residential and retail commercial uses to newer retail and commercial office facilities. Large office buildings are visible to the north and east of the subject property. The two apparent service stations visible in the 1979 aerial photograph are still present in this photo.

1992 Aerial Photograph

The subject property is visible in its current state as a parking lot. Commercial and retail facilities are built up to the property line on the west and south sides of the property. Interstate 880 is visible 500 feet to the west. Interstate 980 is visible approximately one half mile north of the subject property. The immediately surrounding properties are retail or commercial office facilities with vacant lots interspersed. Within a quarter

mile east, west, and south, large office buildings are visible. The Port of Oakland facilities are modernized and several large terminals and cranes are visible. The large natural gas storage tanks are no longer visible and appear to have been removed. The properties adjacent to the port facilities are visible as industrial and commercial use areas. The Bay Area Rapid Transit tracks are underground in this area, and the station access facilities are visible along Broadway.

No evidence of waste disposal or land-filling which could pose an environmental threat to the site was observed in the aerial photographs.

4.3 SANBORN Map Review

GSI reviewed SANBORN maps from 1889, 1902, 1912, 1951, 1952, and 1970 for the subject property. The SANBORN maps cover the area from Jefferson Street to Broadway and 6th Street to 8th Street. The SANBORN maps indicate that the subject property was used for a saloon, boarding house, restaurant, and retail facility between 1889 and 1952. The 1970 SANBORN map shows the subject property as a service station with underground storage tanks on site. The 1970 SANBORN map also shows what appears to be a gasoline dispensing facility with an inderground storage tank at the Oakland Police Department parking facility at 6th Street and Broadway. There is no indication on the SANBORN maps of any other underground storage tanks in the area covered.

5.0 SITE INSPECTION OBSERVATIONS

5.1 Site Inspection

5.1.1 Subject Property

GSI conducted a physical inspection of the subject property on June 21, 1993. The property is currently used as a public parking lot and has space for 63 automobiles. The lot is enclosed on two sides by a four foot high chain link fence with black vinyl slats. The 7th Street side of the property is bounded by a fifteen foot high concrete wall (the back wall of the restaurants and commercial facilities along 7th Street and Broadway). A former restaurant and lounge, Dahlkes, at 26 Broadway is the adjacent property to the west of the subject property. The remaining side of the property is bounded by the five story high masonry wall of the building immediately adjacent to the north of the site, identified as 477 8th Street, the Asian Job Opportunity Office. There are three driveways accessing the subject site, one on 8th Street and two on Broadway. The asphalt is in good condition with very little cracking. There is minor visible staining of the asphalt from cars parked on the site. No structures exist on the subject property. A small fenced area (approximately ten square feet) is located in the corner opposite 8th and Broadway. Some trash and garbage, cans, bottles, and newspapers, are visible within this enclosure.

5.1.2 Adjacent Properties

GSI reviewed the City of Oakland building files for permits issued on the subject property to evaluate construction activities at the site that may have affected the environment. Review of the files revealed that underground storage tanks existed on the subject property from 1965

until 1980. The product piping was replaced because of leskage in 1979.

The underground ratiks, piping, and service station building were removed in 1980. The property remained vacant until 1984, when it became a parking lot. There are currently no activities at the subject site of environmental concern. The only permits on file were the building permits for the 1965 service station construction and subsequent piping replacement and station demolition in 1974, 1979, and 1980.

There is an undocumented reference, provided by Shell Oil Company, for the subject property which indicates that the Oakland Police Department removed and replaced leaking underground storage tanks at their parking lot located at the intersection of Broadway and 6th Suscer. No regulatory files concerning this site were discovered by GSI during the course of this investigation. A permit to repair the product lines and dispensers at the Police Department parking lot was taken out in 1984 by the Egan and Paradiso company, but no additional information was available. Personal communication between GSI and the Oakland Public Works Construction Division revealed that the product lines at the police facility were tested in 1988, and found to be intact. The lines passed a pressurized leak test and were abandoned in place. There are no regulatory files to indicate that a soil or groundwater investigation has been performed at this site.

GSI reviewed of the City of Oakland building permit records and Oakland Fire Department records to determine if (re)development activities on the adjacent properties could have had an environmental impact on the subject property. The available records did not reveal any construction activities on the surrounding properties that may have been or currently are of any environmental significance to the subject property.

5.2 Topography, Geology and Groundwater

The subject site is located on the flat lying surface of the San Francisco Bay Plain approximately 35 feet above mean sea level (Appendix 10.3, Plate 1). The active Hayward Fault is mapped approximately four miles to the northeast near the base of the East Bay Hills. The Oakland Estuary, a channel of San Francisco Bay separating Oakland from Alameda, is located one half mile southwest of the subject property. Lake Merritt is located three quarters of a mile east of the subject property.

Radbruch and Case, 1967, map the subject property as Merritt Sands, a quaternary age sedimentary deposit consisting of fine to medium grained sand with minor organic materials. Soil boring data from the UST removal project at 706 Harrison (Dennis Bates Associates 1993) and the environmental assessment of the Bramelea project at 11th and Broadway (Woodward-Clyde Consultants 1988) confirm that the site is underlain by Merritt Sands inter-fingered with Bay Mud. Helley, LaJoie, Spangle, and Blair 1979, describe the Bay Mud as unconsolidated, olive gray, blue gray, or black silty clay.

Based on data from groundwater monitoring wells in the area, groundwater at the site occurs to the second to the second to the second to the second to the gradient is nearly flat. This area of Oakland has undergone extensive redevelopment and many large office buildings have recently been built, affecting the local hydraulic conditions.

5.3 Hazardous Materials Use and Storage

GSI's site inspection of the subject property revealed that there are no hazardous materials stored on the subject property. GSI contacted the offices of ALLRIGHT PARKING and was informed that no materials considered hazardous are currently stored or used at the subject site.

GSI's review of the regulatory files found no evidence of past or present on-site or off-site disposal practices that could pose an environmental threat to the subject property. None of the files reviewed indicated any violations against the subject property involving environmental concerns.

5.4 - Underground and Atoriogramial Storage Tables

File review conducted by GSI revealed that the underground storage tanks, and associated piping, used for the operation of the American Oil Company service station and then by the Shell Oil Company service station were removed in May 1980. Information provided by Shell Oil Company indicates that in January 1979 the Bay Area Rapid Transit District the Dis

removed all existing improvements, underground storage tanks, and

associated piping, and vacated the site. GSI's review of the City of

Oakland building permit files revealed that Shell Oil Company obtained permits to demolish the service station and remove the USTs and associated piping in accordance with existing regulations. No additional regulatory information is available regarding the UST removal. In December 1031 a recovery system was installed on the City of Oakland property located at the southwest corner of 7th and Broadway to remove the flydrocarbon contamination. The contamination was discovered during a 1981 soil and groundwater investigation of the subject property performed by Groundwater Technology Inc. Shell Oil Company had the recovery system shut down in August of 1982 because the hydrocarbon concentrations in the effluent exceeded the discharge requirements of the discharge permit. The recovery system was subsequently removed in 1986.

Groundwater monitoring wells, identified as S-1, S-2, and S-3, located on the subject property were destroyed during construction activities at the subject site. The GSI site visit included an inspection of the entire property for evidence of any remaining USTs. Areas of the property were inspected

for vents, fill pipes, or unexplained concrete patching. No evidence suggesting the presence of USTs or aboveground storage tanks was observed during the site visit.

5.5 Utilities

The subject property does not have natural gas service, drinking water, sewer service, or garbage service. GSI's site inspection did not reveal any electrical service to the property. There is no outdoor lighting for the public parking facility that occupies the site. Pacific Gas and Electric provides natural gas and electrical service for the nearby buildings.

There are no septic systems on the subject property. Storm water runoff is provided by public storm drains. The nearest surface waters are the Oakland Estuary one half mile southwest of the subject property and Lake Merritt three quarters of a mile east of the site. There are no domestic, irrigation, or municipal well within a one mile radius of the subject property.

5.6 Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs)

PCBs were widely used in the electrical manufacturing industry until the mid-1970s, when they were banned from use because they pose a threat to human health and the environment. In 1979, the US EPA prohibited the use of PCBs as a dielectric fluid.

GSI inspected the property for electrical equipment that may contain polychlorinated biphenyls. No electrical transformers or electrical devices were observed on the subject property. An inspection of the surrounding area showed that there are no transformers on power poles in the nearby

area Because there are no sources for PCBs from electrical equipment on the site or nearby the site, PCBs are of little environmental concern to the subject property.

5.7 Asbestos Screening

Asbestos is a generic term used to describe a group of naturally occurring silicate materials that have been linked to a number of health problems, including asbestosis, mesothelioma, and lung cancer. The most widely used types of asbestos are chrysotile and amosite. Others include crocidolite, tremolite, anthophylite, and actinolite. GSI's physical site inspection of the subject property did not reveal the presence of any suspected asbestos-containing materials.

5.8 Radon

Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas found in soils and rocks; derived from the natural decay of radium. Radon is an odorless, colorless, carcinogenic gas believed to be harmful at all exposure levels. Radon can accumulate in enclosed spaces. There is an increased chance of developing lung cancer when exposed to elevated levels of radon. In general, the risk increases as the levels of radon and length of exposure increase. The EPA has established a guidance level of 4 picocuries per liter (Pci/L) of radon in indoor air for residences. There have been, however, no standards established for commercial structures. Radon gas accumulations above 4 Pci/L are considered to represent a health risk to occupants. Because there are no structures on the subject property that could facilitate the accumulation of radon gas, radon is not an environmental concern at this site.

5.9 Lead

GSI did not conduct testing for the presence of lead in the paint at the at the subject property. It is possible that there is lead in the paint on the exteriors of the buildings which border two sides of the subject property. However, because the site was in use as a service station from 1965 until 1980 and lead was a component of gasoline during that period, the potential for lead contamination in the soil exists.

6.0 REGULATORY REVIEW

GeoStrategies, Inc. (GSI) contacted a number of federal, state, and local regulatory agencies/offices for information regarding additional issues, compliance with applicable regulations, and human health concerns. The results of these inquiries and associated records research are discussed in this section. A list of information sources consulted in the preparation of this report is presented in Appendix 10.4

GSI conducted a database search consisting of the following sources:

This database search was used to obtain information on environmental concerns associated with the subject property and within a radius of one mile of the property. This search includes a review of publicly available

database information sources. Some sites, depending upon the nature of the environmental problem they present, will be present on more than one list. When a site appears on multiple lists, the discussion of that site is held under the section considered to be most pertinent to this report. A copy of the database information and a description of the different database sources reviewed is available in Appendix 10.4.

6.1 Federal Records

6.1.1 CERCLIS and NPL Databases

GSI reviewed the CERCLIS and NPL to determine if the subject property is included for investigation. EPA's CERCLA (or Superfund) program provides for liability, compensation, cleanup, and emergency response for hazardous substances released into the environment, and for cleanup of inactive or uncontrolled hazardous waste sites. As part of this program, sites meeting certain criteria are required to notify the EPA and are catalogued on the CERCLIS database. Once catalogued, these sites are evaluated to determine whether they present a threat to human health or the environment and, therefore, require remedial action. The CERCLIS sites that are determined to require further investigation are then scored using the Hazard Ranking System: sites scoring above a certain level are considered for placement on the NPL for additional study and remediation.

GSI's review revealed that the subject property is not included on the CERCLIS or NPL. Seven sites are listed in CERCLIS and are located within one mile of the property. GSI reviewed files for five of the seven sites. The files for the Oakland Naval Supply Center/Alameda Facility and the 54 Embarcadero Property were not available for review during the course of

this investigation.

Francis Plating, located at 785 7th Street, three eighths of a mile northwest of the subject property, had a fire that was investigated by the Environmental Protection Agency on November 18, 1992. Francis Plating specializes in nickel plating, cadmium plating, aluminum anodizing, and chromic acid passivation. Fire cleanup involved storing and treating waste liquids, properly removing fire damaged equipment, and preventing run-off from the property to the surface waters. The EPA indicated that there was some airborne contamination to the neighboring properties but not significant amounts. There was minor chromium contamination in the Oakland Estuary. The Francis Plating Company was operational on a limited basis by February 1993. Based on the distance from the subject property and nature of the environmental problem at the Francis Plating facility, GSI believes the Francis Plating Company to be of little environmental concern to the subject property.

Nor-Cal Metal Fabricators, located at 1121 3rd Street, three quarters of a mile west of the subject property, welds, cuts, and bends sheet metal; primarily steel stainless steel and aluminum. The waste products at this site include solvents and sludges. According to the Department of Health Services (DHS) Preliminary Assessment (PA) summary all wastes are hauled off-site by a licensed hauler. The DHS inspection of the property revealed no violations and recommended that no further action be taken. Based on this information, GSI considers this site to be of no environmental concern to the subject property.

Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) owned and operated a Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) from 1903 to 1958, located at 1st and Washington approximately one half mile southwest of the subject property. The plant

used crude oil to create gas for electrical generation and home use. The plant was closed in 1958 and dismantled in 1961. Currently PG&E uses a portion of the property as a gas load station and electric generation facility. Typical MGP operations produce tars, light oils, sludges, and lampblack as waste. Although there is no documented releases or threatened release at the site, PG&E is currently performing an environmental assessment of the property to determine if there is an threat to public health or the environment. Based on the fact that this site down gradient of the subject property with respect to groundwater flow, and the distance from the subject property, GSI believes that this site is of little environmental concern to the subject property.

Sherex Chemical Company, located approximately one mile west of the subject property at 1401 Middle Harbor Road, manufactured cleaning products. These products consisted of nitrogen based and fatty based chemicals for soaps. The facility opened in 1929 as the El Dorado Oil Works and used coconut oils as raw materials. El Dorado started using methyl esters in the 1940's for it's raw materials. In the 1960's Foremost, who had bought the facility started using fatty nitrogens to manufacture dish washing detergents. Sherex Chemicals acquired the plant and closed operations in 1986. In June 1986 Sherex Chemical was served a notice of violation by the Alameda County District Attorney. These violations consisted of improper storing and labelling of hazardous wastes, not providing secondary containment for certain chemicals, and that the Alameda County Division of Environmental Health suspected unreported releases of chemicals into the environment. Sherex Chemical instituted an environmental investigation of their facility. investigation revealed heavy metal, priority organic pollutants, and oil and grease in the soil and groundwater at the site. (However, GSI feels that due to the distance from the subject property and the nature of the

contamination at the Sherex Chemical facility, that this site is of little environmental concern to the subject property.

Safety-Kleen Corporation is located at 404 Market Street, approximately one half mile west of the subject property. This facility is a supplier and reclaimer of parts cleaners, such as mineral spirits, dry cleaning solvents, and immersion cleaners. The used cleaning fluids are stored in 12,000 gallon underground storage tanks. The used shipping drums are stored on site and periodically removed by a licensed hauler. In 1989 the DHS issued a notice of violation to Safety-Kleen for open containers, missing records, a release to the environment, inadequate labelling of containers, and leaking containers. Safety-Kleen responded to these violations and was granted a permit to operate by the EPA. DHS made a negative declaration for the project and stated that there would be no significant threat to the environment from the proper operation of the plant. The 1993 first quarter groundwater monitoring report for the Safety-Kleen facility documents the on-going soil remediation project. This project is in response to the detection of mineral spirits impacted soil during the replacement of single walled storage tanks in 1990. Mineral spirits were detected in the soil but not in the groundwater in the January 1993 sampling. TCE, DCA, and PCE were detected in the groundwater at concentrations in the range of 1.3 micrograms per liter (ug/l) to 5500 ug/l in eight monitoring wells and not detected in the three other monitoring wells. (Because of the on-going remediation project at this site and the distance from the subject property, GSI feels that this site is of little environmental concern to the subject property.

The Oakland Naval Supply Center/Alameda Facility located at 2155 Mariner Square Loop, Alameda approximately one mile south of the subject property is listed on the CERCLIS. However, the regulatory files

for this site were not available for review during the course of this investigation.

54 Embarcadero located at Fallon and Embarcadero three quarters of a mile southeast of the subject property is listed on the CERCLIS. However, the regulatory files for this site were not available for review during the course of this investigation.

6.1.2 Federal Superfund Liens

Under Section 107(L) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA) 42 U.S.C. Section 9607(1). EPA has the authority to file liens against real property to recover cleanup, response, and other expenditure made by EPA under the CERCLA program. EPA has prepared a listing of filed notices of Superfund Liens that is updated quarterly. Because these liens are "statuary Liens", they arise when the agency spends money on a site or when notification of potential liability is received by the owner of the property. EPA maintains that these liens can arise without filing, however, and they suggest checking CERCLIS sites for lien status. GSI's review revealed that the subject property is not included on the LIENS; in addition, there are no LIENS sites located within one mile of the site.

6.2 State and Local Records

6.2.1 Hazardous Waste and Substances

The California Governor's Office of Planning and Research annually publishes a listing of potential and confirmed hazardous waste sites throughout the State of California under Government Code Section

65962.5. Review revealed that the subject site is included on the CORTESE list. However, there are five other CORTESE sites of concern within one half mile of the subject property. These five sites are discussed in Section 6.2.7.

6.2.2 CAL-SITES (AWP)

The Annual Work Plan (AWP) contains a listing of all verified hazardous waste sites that are, or will be, targeted for abatement by the California Environmental Protection Agency under the Hazardous Substances Cleanup Bond of 1984 (Health and Safety Code Section 25356) and the Hazardous Substances Account (HSA). Hazardous waste sites may be discovered by the department directly or referred to the department for confirmation and follow-up action by another government agency, such as a local health department, a Regional Water Quality Control Board, a responsible party, or a concerned citizen. New sites are added to this database as they are verified and the "Preliminary Assessment, Site Investigation and Hazard Ranking System" process are completed. This database is updated once annually after approval of the California State Legislature and has been incorporated into the CAL-SITES database, which currently contains a list of approximately 450 sites in the State of California. Review revealed that the subject property is not included on the AWP; there is, however, one known AWP site located within one mile of the subject property, the Alameda Annex Naval Supply Center located at 2155 Mariner Square Loop, Alameda. As previously stated in section 6.1.1, the regulatory files for this site were not available for review during the course of this investigation.)

6.2.3 Border Zone Property Act Sites

In accordance with Assembly Bill 816 and the Hazardous Waste Property/border Zone Property Law (Health and safety Code 25220) and CAL-EPA, Toxic Substances Control Program (TSCP) enters into voluntary deed restriction agreements with owners of property who propose building residences, schools, hospitals, or day care centers on property that is "on or within 2,000 feet of a significant disposal of hazardous waste." Restrictions may include "activities on, over, or under the land, including, but not limited to, a prohibition against building, filling, grading, excavating, or mining" without the written permission of the TSCP.

This bill requires the TSCP to "notify the planning and building departments of each city, county, or regional council of governments when a land use restriction has been recorded, and would require the planning or building department to enforce the restriction," although the TSCP has compiled a list of properties subject to environmental deed restrictions that is used to notify various building and planning departments in local jurisdictions. Review revealed that the subject property is not included on the Deed Restrictions list; however, there is one known site listed within one mile of the subject property.

GSI reviewed the files for the Clorox Company located at 1221 Broadway one quarter mile north of the subject property. The review revealed that Clorox is listed on BZP because they maintain their own phone switching system at the Clorox building. This system requires that, as an emergency power failure backup, a room full of large batteries are on site.

GSI believes that this facility is of little environmental concern to the subject property.

6.2.4 CAL-SITES (ASPIS)

Developed under Section 25359.6 of the Health and Safety Code, the California EPA Toxic Substances Control Program (TSCP) maintains a listing of potential and known hazardous waste sites. TSCP staff have interviewed officials from county health agencies, local fire departments, county agricultural commissioners, and other local agencies that could reasonably be expected to have information regarding potential waste sites. The Regional Water Quality Control Boards, Department of Fish and Game, and other state environmental regulatory agencies' TSCP staffs also review historical land use data sources to generate lists of potentially contaminated sites.

This database was formerly known as the Abandoned Site Program Information System (ASPIS), but was integrated into the CAL-SITES database in 1991. Information concerning most of these sites should be considered preliminary, although most confirmed sites from this database are merged into the AWP once they have undergone the hazard ranking process. This database currently contains more than 26,000 sites in the State of California. Review revealed that the subject property is not included on the ASPIS. Sixteen sites within one half mile of the subject site are, however, listed on the ASPIS. All but one of these sites have been designated "NFA", indicating that they have been investigated by the state and found to require No Further Action.

GSI reviewed the files for Lakeside Non-Ferrous Metal Fabricators located at 412 Madison Street, one half mile southeast of the subject property. An inspection by the Alameda County Environmental Health department revealed minor oil spillage on the ground next to a drum. Additionally, the owner stated that he removed an underground storage tank used for

gasoline storage. The file did not indicate an time frame for the tank removal nor did it indicate that there was any environmental impact from the tank. Based on this information and the distance from the subject property, this site is of little environmental concern to the subject property.

6.2.5 Hazardous Waste Information System

The California Department of Health services, Toxic Substances Control Division, has developed and maintained lists of hazardous waste generators and hazardous waste treatment storage and disposal facilities in the State of California, pursuant to the Hazardous Waste Control Law (Health and Safety Code Section 25100 et seq.), and the Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1976 (Health and Safety Code Section 25179.1 et seq.). In addition, this law requires all counties to prepare and submit hazardous waste management plans. The Toxic Substance Control Division maintains lists containing generation and disposal data within This information has been assembled by the Toxic Substances Control Division from manifest reports required from hazardous waste generators. This database currently lists over 50,000 sites in the State of California. GSI's review of the HWIS revealed that the subject site is not listed. Forty four sites within one mile of the subject site are listed on the HWIS. These sites are all currently regulated by the state and are not considered to be of environmental concern-

6.2.6 Solid Waste Information System

The California Integrated Waste Management Board maintains an inventory list of both open as well as closed and inactive solid waste disposal facilities and transfer stations pursuant to the Solid Waste

Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972, Government Code Section 2.66790(b). Generally, the California Integrated Waste Management Board learns of locations of disposal facilities through permit applications and from local enforcement agencies. Since 1977, the SWIS system has grown to track over 1,000 solid waste disposal facilities and transfer stations in the State of California. GSI's review of the SWIS revealed that the subject site is not included on the SWIS list; in addition there are no known SWIS sites within one mile of the subject property.

6.2.7 Leaking Underground Storage Tanks

The California State Water Resources Control Board, in cooperation with the Office of Emergency Services, compiles lists of all leaks of hazardous substances from Underground Storage Tanks (USTs) in the State of California pursuant to Section 25295(b) of the Health and Safety Code. The nine regional boards maintain information on all reported leak cases within their jurisdiction, both for those where the regional boards and other local agencies take the lead in overseeing investigations and remedial actions. GSI visited the Oakland, California offices of the San Francisco Bay Area Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) on June 23, 1993 to review files for known LUSTs within one quarter mile of the subject property. GSI reviewed files for the following seven sites:

764). 50 The parking let 19th and Jefferson, located one quarter of a mile northwest of the subject property, previous to 1953, was used as a service station and contained four 550 gallon underground storage tanks. The Woodward-Clyde Consultants 1991 Hydrocarbon Remediation Program for this site states that there is soil contamination in the range of 32,000 parts per billion (ppb) to 46,000 ppb TPH-G in a layer 20-24 feet below grade. TPH-G concentrations of 26,000 ppb and BTEX

concentrations of 7500 ppb have been observed in the groundwater in the northeast corner of the property. Woodward-Clyde Consultants have measured the groundwater flow direction as southeast. This site is a quarter of a mile from the subject property, however based on the up gradient location of this site, the nature of the hydrocarbon contamination, and the fact that there are no off-site monitoring wells to monitor potential off-site hydrocarbon migration, GSI because the transfer of environmental concern to the subject property. GSI recommends a periodic review of the regulatory files concerning the 9th and Jefferson property to assess any off-site movement of the hydrocarbon contamination.

GSI reviewed the file for Chinatown Redevelopment Project located at 11th and Webster one quarter of a mile northeast of the subject property. According to the Harding-Lawson Associates (HLA) letter to the DHS, dated October 7, 1988, concerning the remediation of this site, in April of 1987 underground storage tanks removed from under the sidewalk as part of the construction project for the East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) high-rise office complex. Another area of hydrocarbon contaminated soil was discovered in the northeast corner of the EBMUD site. There is no indication in the letter of any groundwater contamination at this site. HLA outlined a plan to aerate some soil and remove other soil stockpiles from the site Based on the distance from the subject property and apparent lack of groundwater contamination at this site, this site is not likely to impact the subject property.

GSI reviewed the file for the **Partic Particle Place located** at 9th and Webster, three sixteenths of a mile east of the subject property. The Harding-Lawson Associates (HLA) site update to the RWOCB dated October 8, 1988, states that there was formerly a service station on this

property, at the corner of 10th and Webster. Results of soil and groundwater sampling indicated elevated levels of TPH-G and BTEX in the soil and groundwater. HLA indicated that the groundwater flow direction at this site are generally westerly. HLA concluded, based on the results the 19 on-site soil borings that it is likely that soil and groundwater contamination extend laterally beyond the site boundaries. GSI believes based on the subject property and the subject property. GSI recommends that periodic investigation of the regulatory files concerning this site be performed to assess the impact to the subject property of off-site migration of the hydrocarbon contamination.

GSI reviewed the file for Alex Shaw and Associates property ceases at Frankin Street, one eighth of a mile east of the subject property. This property was a former service station site and five USTs are known to have been on this site. One was removed prior to any regulatory investigation and no information exists concerning its contents. According to the "Report on Subsurface Investigation Related to Well Installation and Borings, Miller Environmental Company, 1992", four USTs were removed in June of 1989: two 6000 gallon gasoline tanks, one 550 gallon waste oil tank, and one 1000 gallon solvent tank. Contaminated soil was excavated from the interior of the property but was not removed from the edges. Groundwater sampling indicated low levels of TPH-G contamination in the range of 38-87 parts per million (ppm) along with associated BTEX contamination (1.3-8.8 ppm). Minor amounts of DCE and chloroform were also detected. The groundwater flow direction in this area is generally west to soutwest. site to the subject property, the hydrocarbon contaminated groundwater. and groundwater flow direction this site is of environmental concern to

the subject property: GSI recommends that a periodic review of the regulatory files concerning this property be made to assess the impact to the subject property of hydrocarbon contaminated groundwater migration from this site.

GSI review of the file for Bramalea Pacific 12th Street Project, located at 12th Street and Clay one quarter mile north of the subject property, revealed that an underground fuel oil tank was encountered during the excavation of this site. According to the Woodward-Clyde Consultants summary letter concerning this site, the 1000 gallon tank was damaged during removal and a tar like substance leaked onto the ground. The spill was contained in an area of approximately 50 square feet. The fuel oil contaminated soil was removed and groundwater was not impacted. Based on the distance of the site from the subject property, lack of groundwater contamination, and nature of the spilled material this site is not likely to impact the subject property.

GSI file review of the Bramalea Pacific 1111 Broadway Project located almost one quarter mile north of the subject property revealed that during excavation for the construction hydrocarbon contaminated soil and groundwater was discovered along the southern edge of the project. The "Construction-Phase Soil and Groundwater Investigations and Environmental Monitoring, January 1991," Woodward-Clyde Consultants documented two rounds of groundwater and soil sampling for this site. The results of that investigation show that low-level hydrocarbon contamination (15ppm TPH-G) occurred in the soil along the south edge of the property in a zone 3 feet thick from eight to eleven feet below the surface. TPH-G concentrations of 25 ppm were found in the groundwater just outside the southern edge of the property. Woodward-Clyde Consultants concluded that contamination was coming from under the

loading dock of the Hyatt Regency Hotel immediately south of the site due to the north to northwest local groundwater flow direction during the dewatering phase of the project. The regional groundwater direction in this area is generally westerly to southwesterly. This flow pattern may have been altered during the de-watering phase of the construction project. However, because the groundwater hydrocarbon concentrations are low and the distance from the subject property, this site is of little environmental concern to the subject property.

GSI reviewed the file for the state of the s quarter of a mile southeast of the subject property. According to "The Workplan for Soil Disposal, Overexcavation, and Groundwater Monitoring Well Installation," Dennis Bates Associates, January 1993 the site was a service station from 1963 until 1985 when the station closed. In January of 1991 four 1000 gallon USTs, two 6000 USTs, and one 250 gallon waste oil tank were removed from the site. Analytical results from one soil boring sample taken at 20-25 feet in the vicinity of the four former USTs show TPH-G concentrations of 19 ppm. BTEX values are 0.83 ppm benzene, 1.5 ppm toluene, 0.88 ppm ethylbenzene, and 2.6 ppm xylene for the same sample. A groundwater monitoring program for this site has been proposed by Dennis Bates Associates, but the initial results are not yet available. 7.0 CONCLUSIONS

GeoStrategies Inc (GSI) has conducted a commercially responsible due diligence survey of the subject property for the purpose of identifying major environmental impairment issues. Based on the site inspection and review of available information detailed in this report, the following environmental concerns associated with the subject property were identified:

- The subject property was used as a gasoline service station from 1965 until 1980. Product lines on the subject site failed pressure tests in 1979 prior to their removal. GSI's file review found to the site of the first station as closed and the USIs removed.
- Known hydrocarbon contamination has been identified in the groundwater immediately adjacent to the subject property.
 The source of this hydrocarbon contamination has not been determined.
- There are seven known Leaking Underground Storage Tank sites within a quarter mile of the subject property. Four of these sites may have impacted soil or groundwater on the subject property.

8.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the conclusions discussed in Section 7.0, GSI recommends the following actions be taken for the subject property facility:

- The RWQCB files for LUST sites located at: the parking lot at 9th and Jefferson, the Pacific Renaissance Plaza at 9th and Webster, the Alex Shaw and Associates property at 800 Franklin, and the Oakland Auto Parts facility at 706 Harrison should be reviewed periodically to determine the status of the contamination at these sites.
- A Phase it soil and groundwater investigation of the subject property should be conducted adjacent to the subject contamination, seen immediately adjacent to the subject property, is present on the subject site prior to any construction activities at the site. Upon conspliction of subsurface investigations, results should be forwarded to the appropriate regulatory agencies.






New sites are added to this database as they are verified and the "Preliminary Assessment, Site Investigation and Hazard Ranking System" processes are completed. This database is updated once annually after approval of the California state legislature and has been incorporated into the CAL-SITES database.

BORDER ZONE PROPERTY ACT SITES (DEED RESTRICTIONS)

The information provided in this report is updated to September, 1992.

In accordance with Assembly Bill 816, and the Hazardous Waste Property/Border Zone Property Law (Health & Safety Code 25220), the CAL-EPA, Toxic Substances Control Program (TSCP), enters into voluntary deed restriction agreements with owners of property who propose building residences, schools, hopitals or day care centers on property that is "on or within 2,000 feet of a significant disposal of hazardous waste". Restrictions may include "activities on, over, or under the land, including, but not limited to, a prohibition against building, filling, grading, excavating, or mining" without the written permission of the TSCP.

This bill requires the TSCP to "notify the planning and building departments of each city, county, or regional council of governments when a land use restriction has been recorded, and would require the planning and building department to enforce the restriction," although the TSCP has compiled a list of properties subject to environmental deed restrictions which is used to notify various building and planning departments in local jurisdictions.

CAL-SITES (ASPIS)

The information presented in this report is updated to September, 1992.

Developed under Section 25359.6 of the Health and Safety Code, the California EPA Toxic Substance Control Program (TSCP) maintains a listing of potential and known hazardous waste sites. TSCP staff have interviewed officials from county health agencies, local fire departments, county agricultural commissioners, and other local agencies that could reasonably be expected to have information regarding potential waste sites. The Regional Water Quality Control Boards, Department of Fish and Game and other state environmental regulatory agencies' TSCP staffs also review historical land use data sources to generate lists of potentially contaminated sites.

This database was formerly known as the Abandoned Site Program Information System, but was integrated into the CAL-SITES database in 1991. Information concerning most of these sites should be considered preliminary although most confirmed sites from this database are merged into the AWP once they have been hazard ranked. This database currently contains more than 26,000 sites in the State of California.

The California Department of Health Services, Toxic Substances Control Division, has developed and maintained lists of hazardous waste generators and hazardous waste treatment storage and disposal facilities in the State of California, pursuant to the Hazardous Waste Control Law (Health and Safety Code Section 25100 et seq.), and the Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1976 (Health and Safety Code Section 25179.1 et seq). In addition, this law requires all counties to prepare and submit hazardous waste management plans. To assist the counties, the Toxic Substances Control Division maintains lists containing generation and disposal data within each county. This information has been assembled by the Toxic Substances Control Division from manifest reports required from hazardous waste generators. This database currently lists over 20,000 sites in the state of California.
