#### Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party four ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

#### **Existence of Unauthorized Release**

In October 1989, one 10,000-gallon unleaded gasoline underground storage tank (UST), one 10,000-gallon diesel UST, one 1,000-gallon diesel UST, and one 550-gallon waste oil UST were removed. Side wall samples collected from the limits of the former UST cavity detected concentrations of total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) ranging from 22.4 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) to 2,100 mg/kg. Concentrations of total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd) ranged from 240 mg/kg to 13,000 mg/kg. Oil and grease were detected in two of the samples collected from the gasoline and diesel UST excavations at concentrations of 54 mg/kg and 35 mg/kg. These contaminant concentrations indicate that an unauthorized fuel release occurred at the subject site.

The organization, individual, trustee, or the trust of A. J. McCosker Construction Company, A.J. and Aileen McCosker, Alfred J. and Aileen C. McCosker Trust, David, A., Dennis W., Dwayne M., and Daryl O. McCosker c/o Dwayne McCosker, McCosker Equipment Corporation Etal c/o President, McCosker Equipment Corporation Etal c/o Dwayne McCosker, Daryl O. & Mary S. McCosker Trustees and McCosker Equipment Etal c/o McCosker Equipment Corporation, Dwayne M. McCosker and McCosker Equipment Corporation Etal are responsible parties because they owned the property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred (Definition 3).

The Hertz Corporation leased the property from the A. J. McCosker Construction Company on April 14, 1969. The Hertz Corporation is a Responsible Party for site because they owned or operated an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1), and had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4). In 1985 the Penske Corporation acquired Hertz's Truck Rental division to form Hertz-Penske Truck Rental. In 1992 Hertz-Penske Truck Rental became known as Penske Truck Rental.

Julie Ann Coliseum Holdings LLC purchased or acquired the property on September 14, 2016. Julie Ann Coliseum Holdings LLC is a Responsible Party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred (Definition 3).
