Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) staff has reviewed the referenced document entitled *Response to SWRCB Resolution 2009-0042 Letter for Reduction in Monitoring* prepared by Conestoga Rovers Associates. ACEH concurs with the inclusion of DVE-9, DVE-12, and DVE-20 in the network of wells that should be monitored on a quarterly basis. As noted in the referenced letter, these wells are part of the dual phase extraction network for ongoing remedial actions at the site and are necessary to monitor the effectiveness of remedial activities as they proceed. Exclusion of these four wells was inadvertent. As a consequence ACEH requests these four wells be monitored quarterly until otherwise determined.
