FYI. Please note we have been attempting to get this agreement done for a couple of months. We were not aware until October that Chevron needed to resolve parcel issues--instead we were just advised until then that documents needed to be recovered from archives--but this parcel information was discussed, clarified and confirmed in our conference call on October 16. In this regard, we are unclear as to why there is further delay but wanted to give you a heads up that to the extent there is delay we have done what we can to move this matter along and request your assistance, to the extent it is necessary.

As (1) we discussed during our September 8 call, (2) I explained in my October 3 and 16 emails to you, and (3) was discussed during the October 16 call with ACDEH, Chevron is working to determine the parcels to which it needs access--in addition to the property that is the subject of the indemnity agreement (and the first amendment). When that determination is made, I'll send you a second amendment for signature (hopefully this week).

Note that we expect the work to take place on or about November 6, 2017.
