



Dear Mrs. Gong:

I was informed by Michael Killoran of All Environmental, Inc. that a tank removal is planned for December 21, 1995 for the waste oil tank located at the above referenced property. This Department is concerned about the possibility of additional tanks being present on the property. This was brought to our attention through Kevin Tinsley, a hazardous material specialist in our inspection group.

According to the information we received, the site was originally a Shell Gasoline Station in the 1960's and records shows that 3 fuel tanks were present on site. We have been unable to find any records confirming the fuel tank removal both in our files and in our database system. Also, during his inspection of the referenced property, Mr. Tinsley observed 4 vent lines cut-off at grade at the north-east side of the building. Hence, based on the information we have, there is a possibility of additional tanks being present on the referenced property.

Please make arrangements within 15 days to conduct a geo-technical survey or use any other available methods to confirm the removal/presence of tanks from the referenced property. If you have any questions, you can reach me at (510) 567-6764.

I understand you are preparing to oversee a waste oil tank removal from this property. You should be aware this facility was originally a Shell Gasoline Station back in the 1960's. At that time there were approximately 3 fuel tanks in addition to the waste oil tank. We have been unable to find any records confirming the fuel tank removals from our file or from any other source. The property owner has been vague when asked to provide documentation or other proof of tank removal work at their site. I observed four vent lines cut-off at grade at the north-east side of the building. These tanks may still be in the ground.

I suggest this office address the fuel tank question in conjunction we the waste oil tank removal to avoid unnecessary complications and bad public relations with property owners.

I am in receipt of the results of the geophysical survey and the results for the soil sampling conducted subsequent to the removal of an underground waste oil tank for the above referenced property.

Although the tank was used to store waste oil, the laboratory results of soil samples submitted to this Department did not include any analysis for oil and grease and PNAs (polynuclear aromatics) as required by the Tri-Regional Valley Guidelines and as mentioned in the tank removal application form submitted to this Department. Hence additional investigation needs to be conducted around the former tank area to determine the presence or absence of oil and grease and PNAs contamination, and if needed, to define the extent of the contamination. Also, the stockpiled soil needs to be tested for oil and grease and PNAs before this Department can make a decision to backfill the excavated soil.

The magnetometer survey did not observe any signs indicative of the presence of underground storage tanks. However, the survey mentions that existing vent lines on site extend to the north, then bend and continue to the northeast up to a distance of 40 feet. The lines were found to truncate near a large asphalted patched area. Since this is highly indicative of a former tank area, additional investigation is required to confirm the presence or absence of any petroleum hydrocarbon contamination. Also, since no historical information is available at this time, the samples should be tested for total petroluem hydrocarbons, as gasoline, diesel and oil and grease, and BTEX, chlorinated solvents, heavy metals, and PNAs.

I am in receipt of the document "Groundwater Monitoring Well Installation Report", dated November 26, 1996 prepared by All Environmental, Inc for the above referenced site.

Based on the results of the soil and groundwater samples submitted to this Department, it is apparent that significant amounts of gasoline, diesel and BTEX. is present down gradient to the former underground storage tank area. Based on a review of pertinent documents, the following additional work needs to be conducted on the referenced site:

- Since significant amounts of petroleum hydrocarbons were identified in the down gradient well, MW-2, further investigation is required to delineate the extent of lateral and vertical contamination. This Department recommends that borings/hydropunches be used to define the contamination in soil and groundwater and based on the results of this investigation a monitoring well down gradient to MW-2 be installed.
- Monitoring wells, MW-2 and MW-3 should be sampled on a quarterly frequency and quarterly reports should be submitted to this Department. Monitoring well, MW-3, which is down gradient to the waste oil tank should be also be sampled for total oil and grease using the EPA 5520 method.

LANDOWNER NOTIFICATION AND PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Dear Heirs of Estate of Wesley D. Jung:

This letter is to inform you of new legislative requirements pertaining to cleanup and closure of sites where an unauthorized release of hazardous substance, including petroleum, has occurred from an underground storage tank (UST). Section 25297.15(a) of Ch. 6.7 of the Health & Safety Code requires the primary or active responsible party to notify all current record owners of fee title to the site of: 1) a site cleanup proposal, 2) a site closure proposal, 3) a local agency intention to make a determination that no further action is required, and 4) a local agency intention to issue a closure letter. Section 25297.15(b) requires the local agency to take all reasonable steps to accommodate responsible landowners' participation in the cleanup or site closure process and to consider their input and recommendations.

For purposes of implementing these sections, you have been identified as the primary or active responsible party. Please provide to this agency, within twenty (20) calendar days of receipt of this notice, a complete mailing list of all current record owners of fee title to the site. You may use the enclosed "list of landowners" form (sample letter 2) as a template to comply with this requirement. If the list of current record owners of fee title to the site changes, you must notify the local agency of the change within 20 calendar days from when you are notified of the change.

If you are the sole landowner, please indicate that on the landowner list form. The following notice requirements do not apply to responsible parties who are the sole landowner for the site.

In accordance with Section 25297.15(a) of Ch. 6.7 of the Health & Safety Code, you must certify to the local agency that all current record owners of fee title to the site have been informed of the proposed action before the local agency may do any of the following:

- 1) consider a cleanup proposal (corrective action plan)
- 2) consider a site closure proposal
- 3) make a determination that no further action is required
- 4) issue a closure letter

You may use the enclosed "notice of proposed action" form (sample letter 3) as a template to comply with this requirement. Before approving a cleanup proposal or site closure proposal, determining that no further action is required, or issuing a closure letter, the local agency will take all reasonable steps necessary to accommodate responsible landowner participation in the cleanup and site closure process and will consider all input and recommendations from any responsible landowner.


