

MEETING MINUTES United States Postal Service (USPS) Emeryville Branch Emeryville, California

Presented for your use and information are the minutes of the 2:00 pm August 17, 1995 meeting at the Alemeda County Department of Health Services offices regarding the Emeryville Branch of the USPS.

At this meeting the concept of a new Workplan for Environmental Engineering Services was developed and agreed upon by each of the attendees. The attendees were as follows:

This meeting was called by Kayode Kadara to re-evaluate the January 5, 1994 Workplan for Environmental Engineering Services based on the four (4) quarterly sampling event results for 1994-1995.

The modified workplan shall contain the following basic parameters:

Implementation of an annual groundwater monitoring program of all existing wells on the USPS property, for 1995-1996.

Further definition of the USPS contamination plume boundary with respect to the Market Place contamination boundary following a meeting with Ravi Arulanathan (RWQCB).

Tests for PCB and Oil/Grease (EPA 5520) will be omitted from future sampling analysis.

Submission of the workplan to Susan Hugo (ACHCSA) for approval.

No need to install additional groundwater monitoring wells.

The consequences for execution of the workplan are as follows:

Re-evaluation of the groundwater sampling program in one (1) year based on groundwater sampling results.

Establish an annual meeting with ACHCSA, the USPS, the Market Place representatives and other Potentially Responsible Parties (PRP) to initiate discussions regarding potential shared responsibility for the continued remediation of the area.

Additional implications for the execution of the workplan are as follows:

Possible candidacy for the USPS Emeryville site to be established as a "non-attainment" zone allowing for contaminant plume to degrade by natural biological action.

Possible inclusion of the USPS Emeryville site as part of one large "non-attainment" area created by the "City of Emeryville Redevelopment Agency".
