Ms. Chu:

At the request of Tosco Marketing Company (Tosco), Environmental Resolutions, Inc. (ERI) is submitting this letter and revised Generalized Site Plan (Attached) for the proposed off-site well locations at the subject site. This letter has been prepared to confirm the telephone conversation between yourself and Mr. Glenn Matteucci of ERI on October 5, 1999. As discussed, Alameda County Health Care Services Agency, Environmental Services (the County) requested that the proposed location of off-site well MW5 provided in ERI's Work Plan for Supplemental Evaluation of Groundwater (Work Plan), dated September 8, 1999, be placed within approximately 150 feet downgradient (northeast) of the subject site.


In response to the request by the County, and upon authorization from Tosco, ERI has proposed, and the County has accepted installation of a second off-site downgradient well (MW6). Groundwater monitoring well MW6 will be installed approximately 150 feet downgradient of the site within the general area requested by the County. Groundwater Monitoring well MW5 will remain at approximately the same location as proposed in ERI's Work Plan. However, wells MW5 and MW6 are proposed to be located within the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Webster Street easement. Therefore, the proposed well locations may vary depending on Caltrans requirements and/or the presence of underground utilities.

As discussed during the October 5, 1999 telephone conversation, proposed boring/well MW6 will be installed and sampled in general accordance with the guidelines provided in ERI's Work Plan.


