Dear Ms. Chu:

This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during February 1993, and site activities anticipated for the month of March 1993.

## February 1993 Activities

- Performed groundwater monitoring.
- Report including results of well installations and vapor extraction test was delivered in final form prior to the February 1, 1993 due date.
- Received and evaluated data from the monthly groundwater monitoring, including data collected from newly installed monitoring wells, and data collected from joint monitoring of sites adjacent to and across from the ARCO site. The ARCO site has limited concentrations of gasoline hydrocarbons in groundwater and no floating product in monitoring wells. It appears other parties upgradient and crossgradient from the ARCO site have more heavily impacted (by gasoline hydrocarbons) sites and these parties will have to conduct offsite investigations to delineate the extent of gasoline hydrocarbons.

## Work Anticipated for March 1993

- O Continue monthly groundwater monitoring, including newly installed monitoring wells.
- O Prepare a formal letter to ACHCSA and RWQCB outlining the results of evaluations of data obtained from the joint monitorings of sites near the ARCO site.
