The above workplan dated April 8, 1997 has been reviewed by the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA). The ACHCSA would like the following additions to the Workplan;

- Provide reports that correlate analytical results from small diameter groundwater sampling points and standard 2-inch diameter groundwater monitoring wells,
- Submit a proposed groundwater sampling point location map,
- Soil and groundwater samples should be analyzed for dissolved oxygen, oxygen-reduction potential, sulfate, nitrate, and iron +2. These parameters are indicators of intrinsic bioremediation,
- Prepare a Tier 1 Human Health Risk Assessment for the site,
- Continue quarterly groundwater monitoring at the site to coincide with the adjacent Motor Partners Site.

Artesian has provided ACHCSA and the Law offices of Tommy A. Conner with the June 10, 1996 Performance Comparison of 0.5-Inch Vs. 4-Inch Ground Water monitoring Wells Test Site in West Los Angeles, California Prepared by Advanced Geo Environmental, Inc. of Anaheim, California.

Artesian concurs with the remaining items specified by ACHCSA, the Tier 1 Human Health Risk Assessment will be prepared after the assessment of data collected from investigation outlined in the workplan and previous investigations.
