### **BACKGROUND:**

The site is currently occupied by an operating Unocal service station. The former UST's were replaced and the waste oil tank was removed. Soil and groundwater investigations have been performed. Hydrocarbon-impacted soils were delineated in the vicinity of the former USTs, product lines, and dispensers. The majority of the impacted soils (1,863 tons) were excavated and transported to an approved landfill.

### RECENT QUARTER ACTIVITIES:

Drilled six soil borings and installed three groundwater monitoring wells. Performed groundwater monitoring and quarterly summary report.

#### **NEXT QUARTER ACTIVITIES:**

Install Oxygen Release Compound (ORC) socks in the three monitoring wells and one tank backfill well. Continue with quarterly groundwater monitoring and summary reporting.
