#### **BACKGROUND**

Unocal Corporation (Unocal) replaced the fuel underground storage tanks (USTs) and removed the used-oil UST. The majority of hydrocarbon-impacted soil (1,863 tons) was excavated and transported to a Unocal-approved landfill. In July 1995, Unocal performed a soil and groundwater investigation that included drilling nine soil borings and constructing three on-site groundwater monitoring wells. During March 1998, Tosco Marketing Company (Tosco) performed an off-site soil and groundwater investigation that included installation of two off-site groundwater monitoring wells south and east of the site. Dissolved methyl tertiary butyl ether and benzene appear to be delineated east and south of the site.
