This correspondence serves to inform the Alameda County Health Care Services that remedial construction activities intended for the Pacific Supply Company, 1735 24th Street, Oakland, California, will begin starting Saturday, September 11, 1993 and proceed through September 24, 1993 as indicated by the enclosed Construction Schedule, prepared by the General Contractor.
