West & Associates Environmental Engineers, Inc. has been authorized by the Weyerhaeuser Corporation, Office of the Environment, to propose construction of one new groundwater monitoring well at the Weyerhaeuser Paper Company facility in Alameda. The new well will be sited based on results of the groundwater screening proposed in our submittal of May 9, It is our intent to site the new well at the southerly edge of the groundwater plume, probably under the main plant building.

The proposed new groundwater monitoring well will be constructed to State Water Board standards as specified in the appendix of our original site investigation workplan (November 1993). The well will be constructed in a boring drilled with a hollow stem auger operated by a driller with a valid California C-57 license. Undisturbed soil samples will be collected for laboratory analysis.

The proposed new well location will be submitted to the Alameda County Health Care Agency prior to its construction. Once completed, sampling of the new well will take place in accordance with our proposed monitoring schedule.
