Dear Mr. Wistar,

Pursuant to our phone conversation on 10–3–89, this letter is to confirm the revisions and authorization to perform the work recommended in the June 30, 1989 Site Characterization Report. Groundwater Resources, Inc. (GRI) will drill a series of borings laterally and downgradient of the suspected release point and obtain groundwater grab samples to ascertain the extreme limits of the groundwater plume at the site (see Plate 1). In addition, a groundwater monitoring well will be placed directly downgradient from MW-5 so that a qualitative groundwater sample could be obtained. After the data is analyzed, at least two more monitoring wells are to be placed downgradient and outside the plume. At that point, the plume should be sufficiently defined so that full scale remediation could proceed.
