This letter provides an update on investigation and remedial activities conducted for the above-referenced site. This update covers site activities performed during August 1991 through October 1991, and site activities anticipated for the month of November 1991.

Status of Previous Months Activities:

August 22, 1991: Performed third quarter 1991 quarterly groundwater monitoring

and sampling. Onsite wells MW-1, MW-2, MW-3, MW-4, MW-5 and MW-6 were sampled for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes (BTEX), and total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH)-

as-gasoline.

September 12, 1991: Received a letter from Alameda County Health Care Services

Agency (ACHCSA) detailing questions and concerns regarding site assessment and remedial activities to date that need to be

addressed.

September 18, 1991: Conducted monthly monitoring of groundwater wells to

determine depth-to-water in each well.
