Molzer presented his opinion that contamination from Plaza Car Wash was coming onto the Alb. Bowl Properties after leaching and after the rains. Hamidi-Fard countered this has not been proven. Hamidi-Fard requested to continue monitoring, and delay remediation until more data is generated. ~~This would~~
RWQCB and Seto informed the parties we had a concern that the plume maybe moving off-site. We asked Stevens to develop an interim measure to control the movement of the plume. Eddie So said the Plaza Car Wash needs to take a more aggressive approach to contain the plume and reestablish the groundwater. It was agreed upon by Stevens, Hamidi-Fard, RWQCB and the County that Stevens will submit a work plan by the 2nd week of Feb '92 identifying his proposed method to contain the plume.
