

Re: CLOSURE OF UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK

Dear Ms. Larkin:

Thank you for the analytical reports concerning the removal of the home heating oil underground storage tank at **1628 Webster Street**, **Alameda**, **CA** on May 4, 2001. The report has been reviewed and it is our opinion that the tank was closed in compliance with Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations.

No further investigations or cleanup actions are required. Please be aware that further work may be required if conditions change or a water quality threat is discovered at this specific site.

Please be advised that residual soil and groundwater contamination does exist at the perimeter of the property at concentrations that should not pose a significant risk to human health. However, a site safety plan should be prepared that will be protective of construction workers in the event excavation is proposed in this area. Any excavated soil and/or groundwater should be properly characterized for disposal.

This office and the San Francisco RWQCB have reviewed the case closure summary for the above referenced site and concur that no further action related to the underground tank release is required at this time. Before a remedial action completion letter is sent, the onsite monitoring wells, MW-1 through MW-3, should be decommissioned, if they will no longer be monitored. Please notify this office upon completion of well destruction so a closure letter can be issued.

Dear Ms. Larkin:

I have completed review of H2OGEOL's September 1995 Soil Sampling, Monitoring Well Installation report for the above referenced site. The report documents the installation of three groundwater monitoring wells and the initial groundwater sampling event.

Groundwater does not appear to be significantly impacted by the fuel release at the site. To verify this, quarterly monitoring of the wells should be established for the site. After four consecutive quarters of sampling, the site will be evaluated for possible case closure. The next sampling event should have been in September 1995. If this has not occurred, you should initiate sampling as soon as possible. Quarterly monitoring reports (QMRs) are due within 60 days upon completion of field work.

I have completed review of H2OGEOL's May 1995 Workplan to Install Three Groundwater Monitoring Wells at the above referenced site. This proposal is acceptable and field work should commence within 60 days of the date of this letter. Please notify me at least 72 hours prior to the start of field activities.

Groundwater samples collected should also be analyzed for chlorinated hydrocarbons (Method 601 or 604), and semi-volatile compounds (Method 8270), in addition to TPH-G, TPH-D, BTEX, and TOG, during the initial sampling event.

Dear Ms. Larkin,

This office has recently received a phone call from a neighbor of the above site who stated that the site was not securely fenced since children were observed playing on the stockpiled soil on your property. This office is very concerned for the health of these children and is requiring that you make certain that this site is not accessible to anyone.

Additionally, it was reported that three to four unlabeled drums were being stored on the site. This office has no records of the storage of these drums or what they are storing. You are required to notify this office immediately, within 10 days of the date of this letter, with information on these drums and how you plan to dispose of these drums. Additionally, you must contact us to confirm that you have secured the site.

The caller, from above, took the initiative to collect two samples from an area bordering your site (one sample from the surface and another from 18 inches below ground surface). These samples were analyzed for lead and identified up to 750 ppm lead on the surface and 450 ppm lead in the deeper sample. addition to the investigations and analysis requirements for petroleum hydrocarbons at your site, this office will also be requiring that you analyze samples collected from your site for lead.

We have received your laboratory report for the samples taken from the above site. The report from Trace Analysis Laboratory dated April 24, 1989, indicated 270 ppm of diesel and 760 ppm of oil and grease were detected in the soil samples underneath the old tank.

Please submit to this office within thirty (30) days from the receipt of this letter, your plan of correction.

Your plan must include, but shall not be limited to:

- 1. Method to determine the vertical and lateral extent of the contamination
- 2. Your EPA identification number
- Name of the licensed hazardous waste hauler
- Name of your disposal facility
