ITT HARTFORD, a.k.a. THE ITT 15 HARTFORD INSURANCE GROUP, and DOES ONE through FIFTY, inclusive, 16 17 Defendants 18 I, Eva Chu, declare as follows: 19 1. I am employed by the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency, Department 2. 20 of Environmental Health ("County"), as a Hazardous Materials Specialist. Unless otherwise 21 noted, I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this declaration and could competently 22 testify to them if called as a witness. 23 My responsibilities at the County include implementation of the local oversight 24 program for the abatement of unauthorized releases of hazardous substances from underground 25 storage tanks ("LOP") by authority delegated to the County by the State Water Resources 26 27 Control Board ("SWRCB") pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 25297 1. 28 1 DECLARATION OF EVA CHU C-96 01575 MHP

- 4. The County has implemented the LOP under this authority since 1991.
- 5. My responsibilities regarding implementation of the local oversight program include requesting that the owners of a contaminated site located in my assigned district (i.e., a site contaminated by the unauthorized release of hazardous substances from an underground storage tank), or other responsible parties ("Responsible Parties"), investigate and remediate the contamination (i.e., take corrective action"), according to work plans which are first reviewed and approved by the County. My responsibilities also include coordinating with the Alameda County District Attorneys' Office ("District Attorneys' Office"), to enforce implementation by the County of the local oversight program when the Responsible Parties fail to cooperate with the County or undertake the requested corrective action.
- I have been the case worker for the property located at 1628 Webster Street,
  Alameda, California.
- 7. The process or procedure of the County for implementing the LOP is to request that the Responsible Parties, investigate and remediate the contamination (i.e., take "corrective action"), pursuant to work plans which may be prepared by the Responsible Parties and have first been approved by the County.
- 8. If the Responsible Parties fail to cooperate and/or take the requested corrective action, the County may invite the Responsible Parties to a "pre-enforcement review" hearing before a pre-enforcement review panel (or "PERP"), which is generally comprised of the County case worker, a supervisor from the County, and a representative from the District Attorneys' Office.
- 9. The Responsible Parties are permitted to explain their failure to comply with the corrective action requests at the pre-enforcement review hearing.
  - 10. Up to 12 to 15 pre-enforcement review hearings are held each month
- 11. Following the pre-enforcement review hearing, the PERP meets and determines specific corrective action requirements and deadlines for the completion of such requirements.
- 12. The Responsible Parties are then notified by the County of such requirements and DECLARATION OF EVA CHU C-96 01575 MHP

deadlines, and of the civil and criminal penalties they may face if they fail to comply as requested.

- If the Responsible Parties fail to comply with the specified corrective action 13. requirements specified by the County, the County may refer the matter to the District Attorney for enforcement action.
- The District Attorney's Office has pursued numerous enforcement actions for 14. failure to comply with such specified corrective action requirements which have resulted in the imposition of penalties, including the incarceration of Responsible Parties, and the payment of fines.
