As I promised by telephone today, I am submitting on behalf of our client, the Learner Company, two reports for your review.

Underground Storage Tank Removal

Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code § 25295 and California Water Code § 13272, I am reporting on behalf of the Learner Company our formal notice of an apparent leakage from an underground tank at the 768 46th Avenue site in Oakland, California. As you know from your presence at the removal, Learner's contractor, R.W. Johnston, and subcontractor, Kaprealian Engineering, acted pursuant to a valid permit to remove an old diesel fuel tank. The tank apparently leaked, and the removal parties have excavated the contaminated soil for proper manifesting and disposal by a licensed hauler to a permitted facility. We shall keep you informed as to the further progress on this matter.
